Main challenge is to make people realize the utmost importance of this subject, its practical implications and involve them from all spheres of the society, beginning from the grass root level.

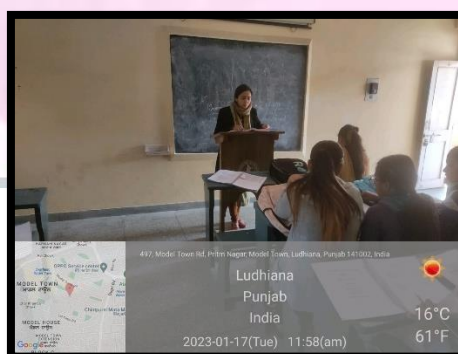

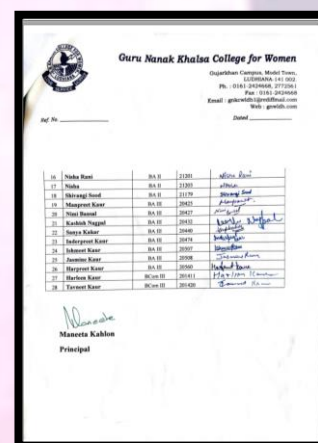
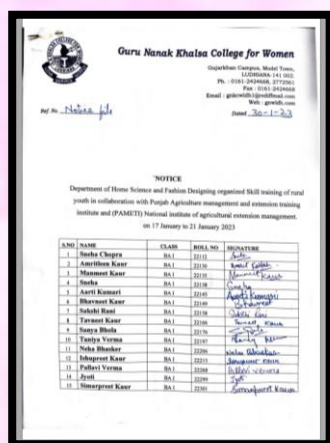
➤ **Skill Training of Rural Youth (STRY) on the theme 'Entrepreneurship Opportunities for youth'**

Skill Development of Rural Youth is a flagship scheme of the Government. The Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Govt. of India, in compliance with National Policy on Skill Development & Entrepreneurship 2015, has taken the initiative to implement the Skill Development Component, namely Skill Training of Rural Youth (STRY) & Farmers Capacity Assessment & Certification (FCAC) under Sub-Mission on Agricultural Extension (SAME) of National Mission on Agricultural Extension & Technology (NMAET) during 2015-16 and remaining period of XII Plan. Under this, Guru Nanak Khalsa College for Women, was selected as Nodal Training Institute (NTI) for conducting training programs.

The college organized Skill Training of Rural Youth (STRY) on the theme 'Entrepreneurship Opportunities for Youth' in collaboration with Punjab Agriculture Management and Extension Training Institute (PAMETI), Ludhiana and National Institute of Agricultural Extension Management (MANAGE), Hyderabad.

Under this, rural youth were imparted training for various skills from 16th to 21st January, 2023. Twenty eight students were trained for crafts like block printing, tie and dye, stencil printing, Crocheting, Knitting and pickle making by resource persons viz Mrs Pritpal, Mrs Harvinder kaur, Mrs Shikha Kalra, Dr Shikha Bajaj and Mrs Amarpreet Kaur. Motivational lectures were given by Dr Harmeet from PAMETI.

The training activities were implemented through SAMETIs at State level & coordinated through ATMA at District level. The SAMETI felicitated the Certification process through the Vocational Training Institutions / Krishi Vigyan Kendras / Nehru Yuva Kendras etc.
