First Week activities

September 3, 2022

The college students and staff pledged to be healthy and nurture our bodies with a good diet and physical activity. A documentary on malnutrition and on the use of millets to eradicate it was screened for 23 Students of Home Science Department. In addition, the students were demonstrated the process of sowing millets. Principal Dr Maneeta Kahlon emphasized on growing millets in the kitchen gardens and encouraged the use of millets in the daily diets.





September 6, 2022

38 Students of Home Science Department prepared highly nutritious, protein-rich Raw Banana Millet Tikkis. This power-packed recipe is beneficial to fight malnutrition.





September 9, 2022

42 Students of Home Science Department made nutritious Dosa using fermented batter. Principal Dr. Maneeta Kahlon emphasized that fermentation enhances the nutritive value of cereals and pulses. In addition, students examined the growth of millets grown in the college nursery. They were found to have become 4inch long saplings.



Second Week activities

September 10

18 Students of Home Science department along with Mrs. Shikha Kalra and Mrs. Amarpreet Kaur visited Jassowal village to explain the importance of millets in their diet by showing a documentary. This was followed by distribution of millet seeds to the rural women.

September 12

15 Students of Home Science Dept. along with Dr. Parveen Arora, Mrs. Shikha Kalra and Mrs. Amarpreet Kaur visited villages Kheri and Jhameri and explained the importance of millets in their diet by showing a documentary along with tasting of kodo millet khichri prepared in the lab with lots of veggies.


In addition, millet seeds were distributed to the rural women.
