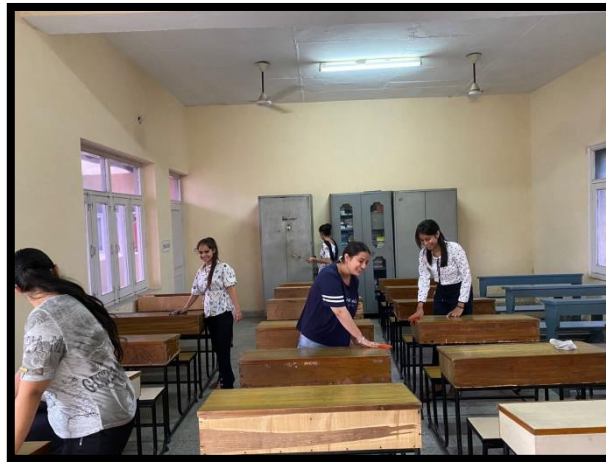



Diwali Celebrations at GNKCW

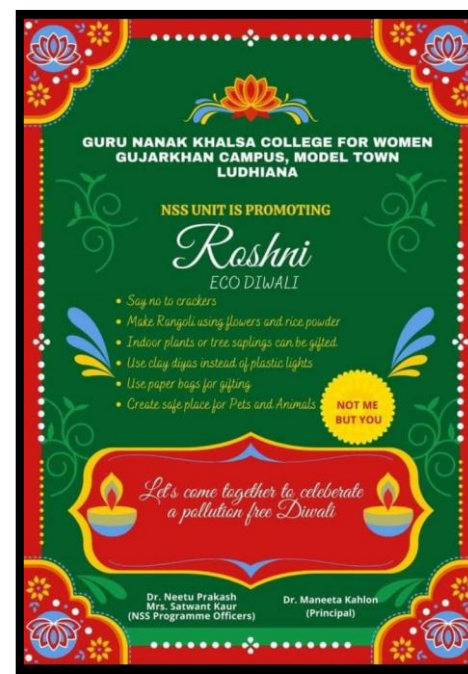


