SEMINAR DETAILS REPORT ON NATIONAL SEMINAR

"ROLE OF PUNJAB IN THE FREEDOM STRUGGLE OF INDIA"

Guru Nanak Khalsa College for Women, Gujarkhan Campus, Model Town, Ludhiana conducted two days National Seminar on 10th and 11th February, 2023 in collaboration with Indian Council of Historical Research. The title of the Seminar was **"Role of Punjab in the Freedom Struggle of India"**. The Seminar was dedicated to the martyrs of Punjab who sacrificed their lives for the freedom struggle of India. It highlighted various aspects of freedom struggle of Punjab and India. The Seminar commenced on February 10 with the welcome address of the college Principal Dr. Maneeta Kahlon. She advised the students to adopt the ideas of the invited scholars in their lives.

After this the convenor of the Seminar Ms. Rajwinder Kaur, Assistant Professor of History shared her views on the role of Punjab in the freedom struggle of India. She informed everyone about the outline of the programs to be held in the Seminar. Many intellectuals were a part of the Seminar and they all gave valuable information about the lives, struggles and sacrifices of the famous and unsung heroes.

Professor M. Rajivlochan, Professor, Department of History, Panjab University, Chandigarh was the chief guest on the first day of the Seminar.. He talked about Pratap Singh Kairon (The former Chief Minister of Punjab) and mentioned all his works for the welfare of Punjab that Kairon had done on the ground level. The keynote speaker of the Seminar was Professor Sukhdev Singh Sohal, Professor and Chair for Study of the Ghadar Movement, Guru Nanak Dev University Amritsar. He talked on 'Free Hindustan at the 75th year of Independence'The next Speaker of the day was Professor Raj Kumar Hans, Retired Professor, Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, Gujarat. He was also the Guest of Honour of the Seminar. While talking about the contribution of Punjab in the Freedom Struggle he said that more than 90 percent of the Punjabis sacrificed their lives for this movement. Instead of all this Punjabis have always suffered discrimination. Talking about Gurdas Alampuria and Hazara Singh Mustak, he told that these two have shown the grim picture of Punjab through their powerful poetry.

In the next phase of the Seminar, Mr. Gurwinder Singh Ji Sarna, Secretary of the Management of College, expressed gratitude towards the guests with his wise words. He told that history tells about many things, incidents, and sacrifices. He shared much information about the whereabouts of Maharaja Ranjit Singh. He talked with the intellectuals about the '*Kaida-e- Noor*' during the times of Maharaja Ranjit Singh. The first resource person of the technical session was Dr Kuldip Singh, Chairperson, Satguru Ram Singh, Chair and Head, Department of History, Central History of Punjab, Bathinda. Dr. Kuldip Singh talked about the role of Malwa in Freedom Struggle. He presented his views on the contribution of the Kuka movement in the freedom struggle in Malwa. The next resource person for the seminar was Dr. Balraj Singh Brar, Assistant Professor, Department of History, Punjabi University, Patiala. He discussed in detail the role played by Press during the time of freedom struggle.

Dr Charanjit Kaur Mann, Associate Professor, ASSM Mukandpur College, SBS Nagar, Punjab. Presenting her views about the incident of Jallianwala Bagh and the life of Shaheed Udham Singh and his contribution in the freedom struggle. The name Jallianwala Bagh was kept after the name of a person named 'Jalla'.She said that the British Government oppressed a lot of people and ordered to shoot many unarmed people without issuing any warrant and without any information. After the incident of Jallianwala Bagh, the oppression of the British government did not end, but they implemented Marshall Law which took away the freedom of people's lives.

The second day of the seminar also began with the welcome address of the College Principal. She insisted on gathering valuable information given by the intellectuals. She also gave an outline about the events of the day. On this day, many renowned dignitaries came to present papers on the topic 'Role of Punjab in the Freedom Struggle of India'. The Presidential Address was given by Prof. Dharmjit Singh Parmar, Vice Chancellor, Sant Baba Bhag Singh University, Jalandhar, Punjab. He discussed in detail about the various movements that took place in Punjab. He also gave a lot of information about the British front-line diplomacy.

He discussed in detail that the 19th century was the era of socio-religious reform movements like AryaSamaj, Singh Sabha, Kuka Movement, Nirankari Movement etc. Dr.Sukhpreet Singh Udhoke, Sikh historian, the Guest of honour of the day told about the role played by Punjab in the Freedom Struggle.

The Seminar's next speaker for valedictory address was Dr.Vinod Kumar, Assistant Director (Research) ICHR, Southern Regional Centre, Bangalore. He also talked about the immense contribution of Punjab in freedom struggle. He said that Punjab is the land of bravery and highlighted that its live example is Gurdwara Sees Ganj Sahib situated in Delhi. People of Punjab have always challenged Britishers. This can be exampled with Lahore conspiracy case and Kamagatamaru incidents.

Dr. Pravin Kumar Sharma, Assistant Director (Research), Indian Council of Historical Research, New Delhi gave information about the various programmes that were running under ICHR. He stated that ICHR provides several Financial Aids. Then he told about the Jallianwala Bagh massacre and said that this was indeed the most brutal act in history. Indians had helped the Britishers during the First World War so that they could get 'Homerule' but Britishers backed out from their words hence leading to rebellion among the Indians.

In the technical session of Day 2, the first resource person was Prof. Manju Malhotra, Retired Professor, Department of History, Panjab University, Chandigarh. She talked about the participation of Women in the Freedom Struggle. Dr. Kanwar Chandardeep Singh, Associate Professor, Department of History, Central University of Himachal Pradesh. talked about various National Movements, socio-religious movements. He also talked about Agrarian taxes that were imposed on Punjab by Britishers.

The last speaker of the Seminar was Dr. Karanbir Singh, Assistant Professor, PG Department of History, Lyallpur Khalsa College, Jalandhar. He said that Punjab's contribution in the freedom struggle was indeed the highest rather 80 percent. During the time of Annexation many people of Punjab went against Britishers and fought two wars; First Anglo war and Second Anglo war. He expressed the contribution of Ghadar movement in the struggle through his beautiful poetry. At the end of the Seminar General Secretary Er. Gurvinder Singh thanked all the scholars for sharing their valuable information on the topic 'Freedom Struggle'. The Seminar provided all the students and the faculty members with a storehouse of knowledge regarding the topic and hence he motivated everyone to find out more about this crucial topic.

Dr. Rajwinder Kaur, Assistant Professor of History and Dr. Madhu Dhawan Assistant Professor of Sociology have handled the dice on the second day of the Seminar.









