I. Curricular Aspects

Giving due consideration to the demand of students for a wide variety of courses, the college plans to introduce **Master Program in Punjabi** and skill oriented courses like **Bachelor of Library (B.Lib.)** The college also plans to introduce new subjects at undergraduate level. **Fashion Designing** as an **Elective Subject** in B.A. and **Introduction to Computer Science** as an **Optional Subject** in all streams are being looked upon as potential options for career opportunities for the students. All these courses will be affiliated to Panjab University, Chandigarh.
