- Various Heads of the departments were directed to prepare Time-tables and teaching plans for the new semester. The work load must be timely calculated and the stock of library books should also be checked.
- Dr. Madhu Dhawan, Head, Department of Sociology should start preparing for the one day national seminar sponsored by College Development Council, Panjab University, Chandigarh on the theme "Towards Gender Inclusivity: Emerging Contemporary Issues around Gender" scheduled on February 4, 2023.
- Dr. Rajwinder Kaur and Mrs. Sandeep Kaur (Department of History) were directed to make preparations for the two-day ICHR Sponsored National Seminar on "Role of Punjab in the Freedom Struggle of India" to be held in the college on February 10-11, 2023
