Preamble

- Create and train among the youth a cadre of peer educators for spreading awareness about HIV-AIDS and its prevention in the community.
- Promote Voluntary non-remunerated Blood Donation among youth


Details of activities conducted by the Youth Club and the Red Ribbon Club



Activity: World Leprosy Eradication Day


Activity Details:

Activity: Interactive session on Cancer awareness at GNKCW


Activity Details:

Dr. Singh, who is currently pursuing research on cancer, enlightened the students and faculty about the causes of cervical and breast cancer, the possible symptoms, diagnosis, and treatment. She also informed the national cancer screening programmes. During her interaction, Dr. Ashrita stressed that early detection is important in the management and treatment of cancer and also prevention by making necessary changes in lifestyle.

This awareness session was convened by Ms. Daisy Wadhwa, coordinator of Red Ribbon Club.

Activity: World Tuberculosis Day


Activity Details:




Date: May 29, 2023
