The objective of STRY was to impart training to rural youth for different skills by organizing various sessions from January 16-21, 2023. The proceedings of various days are mentioned below:

Day 1

Dr. Shikha Bajaj demonstrated block printing and stencil printing methods to the participants. Students practiced the techniques and developed small samples for this. Dr. Harmeet Kaur from PAMETI interacted with students and shared her expertise on entrepreneurship opportunities.

Day 2

Ms. Harwinder Kaur demonstrated different techniques of knitting and Pom Pom making. Total 28 students participated in this activity. Students tried their hand on the techniques and developed small samples of booties and hair bands.

Day 3

Ms. Shikha Kalra demonstrated preservation by pickling and made lemon and mixed veg pickle. Total 28 students participated in this activity. Students learned the standardization technique of the ingredients used in the recipes.

28 students were trained in the fundamentals of crocheting by Mrs. Pritpal. Students were enthusiastic about the art and participated creatively during the session.

World Intellectual Property Day was observed on the campus on April 28, 2023. Dr. Amit Kashyap, Associate Professor in School of Law, Lovely Professional University, Phagwara, Punjab was the resource person.

Keeping in mind the theme of current year, “Women and IP,” Dr. Amit Kashyap discussed the general aspects of various types of property rights including patents, trademarks and copyrights. The process, criteria, prerequisites, duration, rewards to inventor of each IPR was discussed in detail. He mentioned the names of historic patent holders and stressed on the requirement of novelty of the invention, while filling an application for the IPR. Non patentable subject matter was also explained to audiences in order to have a clear understanding. The lecture was attended by 47 Faculty members.

The activity was organized by Mrs. Seema Dua, Dr. Shikha Bajaj and Ms. Neha Dawar. Madam Principal Dr. Maneeta Kahlon graced the event and encouraged the faculty members to involve themselves in quality research and make their way for obtaining Intellectual property rights.
