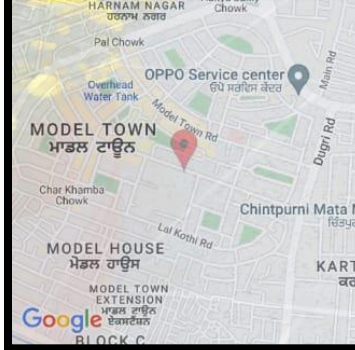


Bhartiya Bhasha Day celebrated at GNKCW
