COURSES

The college is **affiliated to Panjab University, Chandigarh**. At the outset, it was purely an **Arts Degree College** but in response to the changing scenario and the global outlook of the people **Commerce, Computer Science and Business Administration streams** were added in **the academic sessions 1989-90, 2001-02 and 2007-08**, respectively.
