It equips students with both – a rigorous knowledge of the subject as well as a critical and analytical ability. The two year post-graduate program in English (M.A. English) is divided into four semesters. The syllabus (as prescribed by Panjab University, Chandigarh) in each semester introduces the students to literary study and focuses on critical techniques, approaches, and debates to provide the students with the basic tools for research and analysis.

Official Christening of English Literary Society September 29




