Main challenge is to make people realize the utmost importance of this subject, its practical implications and involve them from all spheres of the society, beginning from the grass root level.

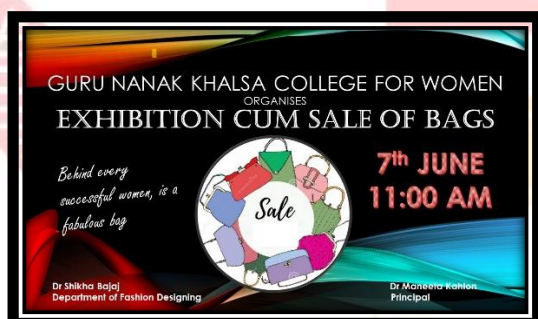

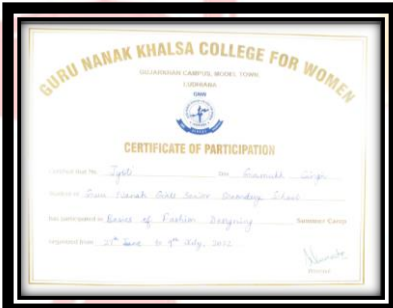
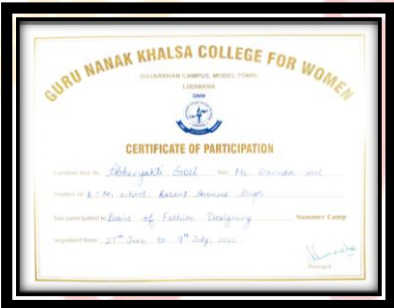


Summer camp concludes at GNKCW

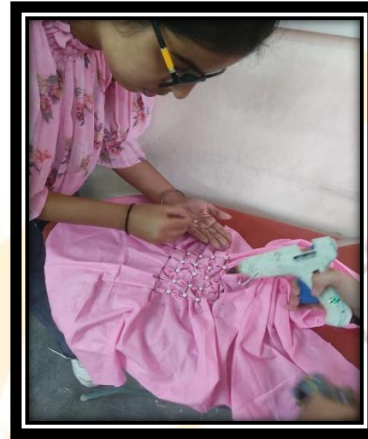

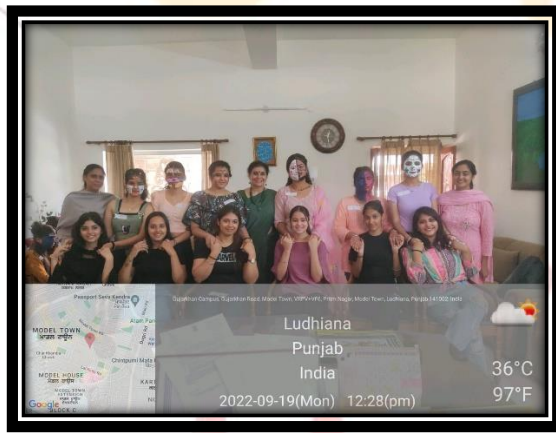




➤ **Face painting competition**

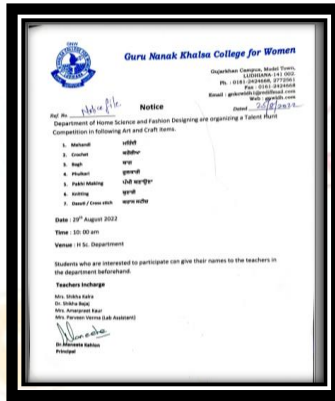
Date	Action taken

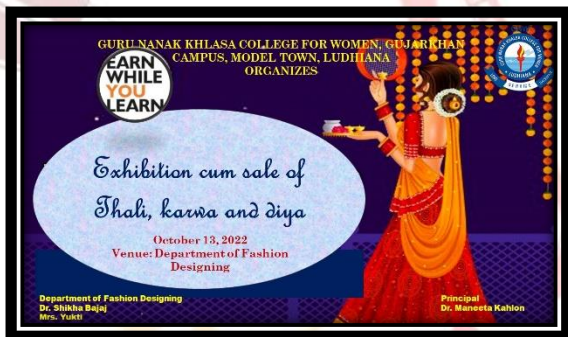
➤ Visit to PAU craft mela
