It equips students with both – a rigorous knowledge of the subject as well as a critical and analytical ability. The two year post-graduate program in English (**M.A. English**) is divided into **four semesters**. 

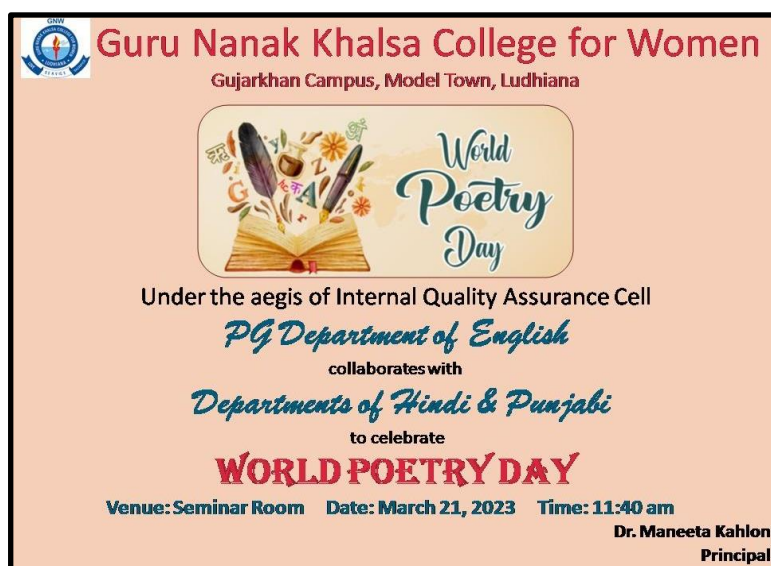
It was decided that the University pattern should be followed for the internal examinations as well, so as to give thorough practice to the students. The teachers of different sections of B.A-I, B.A-II,

9. World English Language Day


April 24
