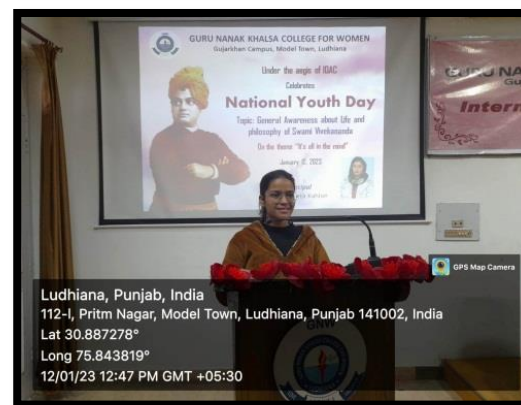
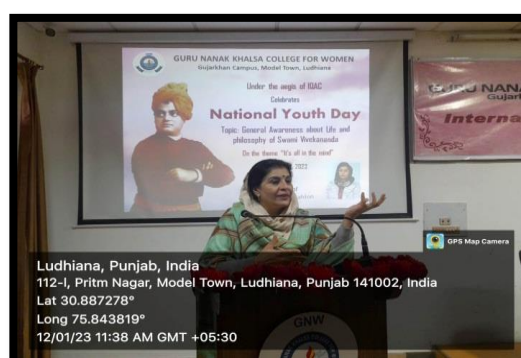
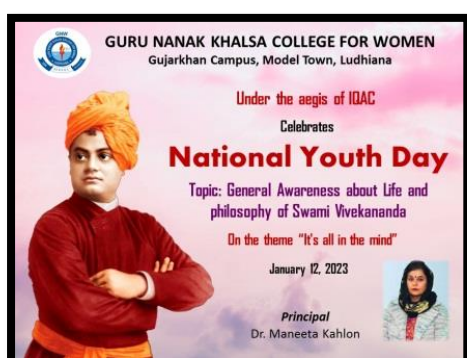
- To motivate the students to follow the traffic rules for their own as well as others safety.

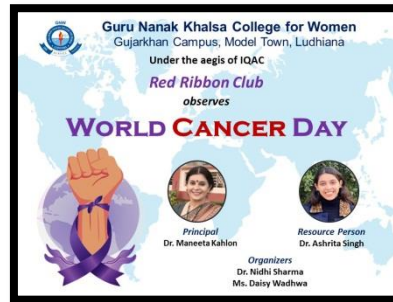
Organize a Seminar on “Idea Generation and Creativity.”
