**Activity:** Awareness Lecture on World Hepatitis Day

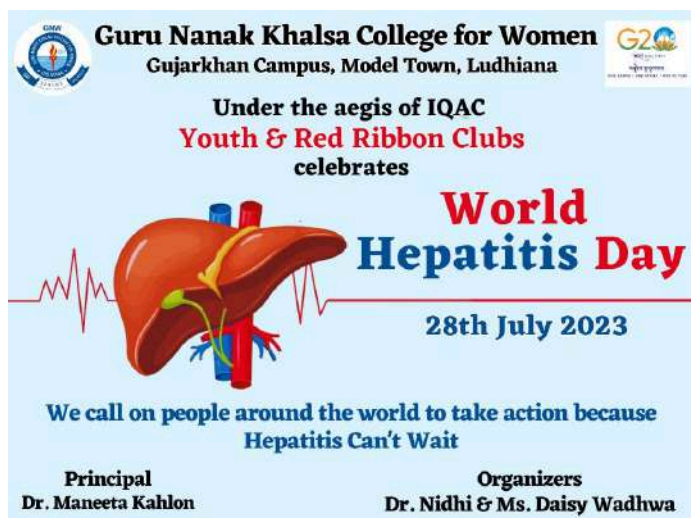
**Activity Details:**

**Activity:** Member Registration Drive

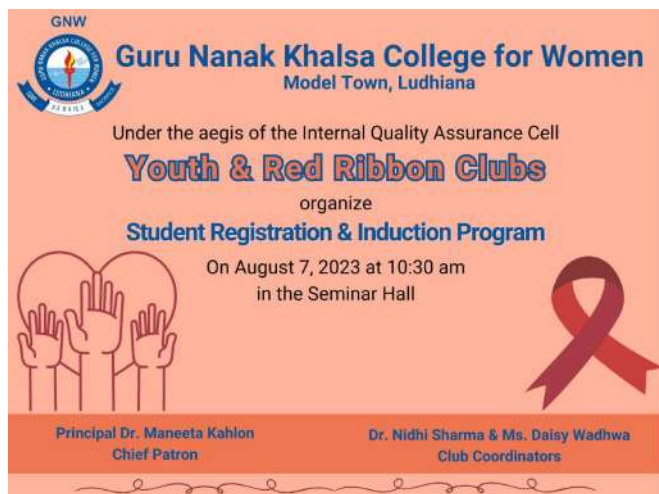
**Activity Details:**



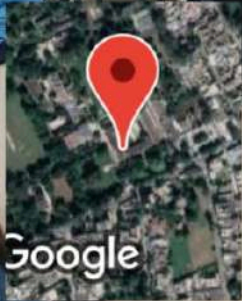

**Activity:** International Youth Day celebrations

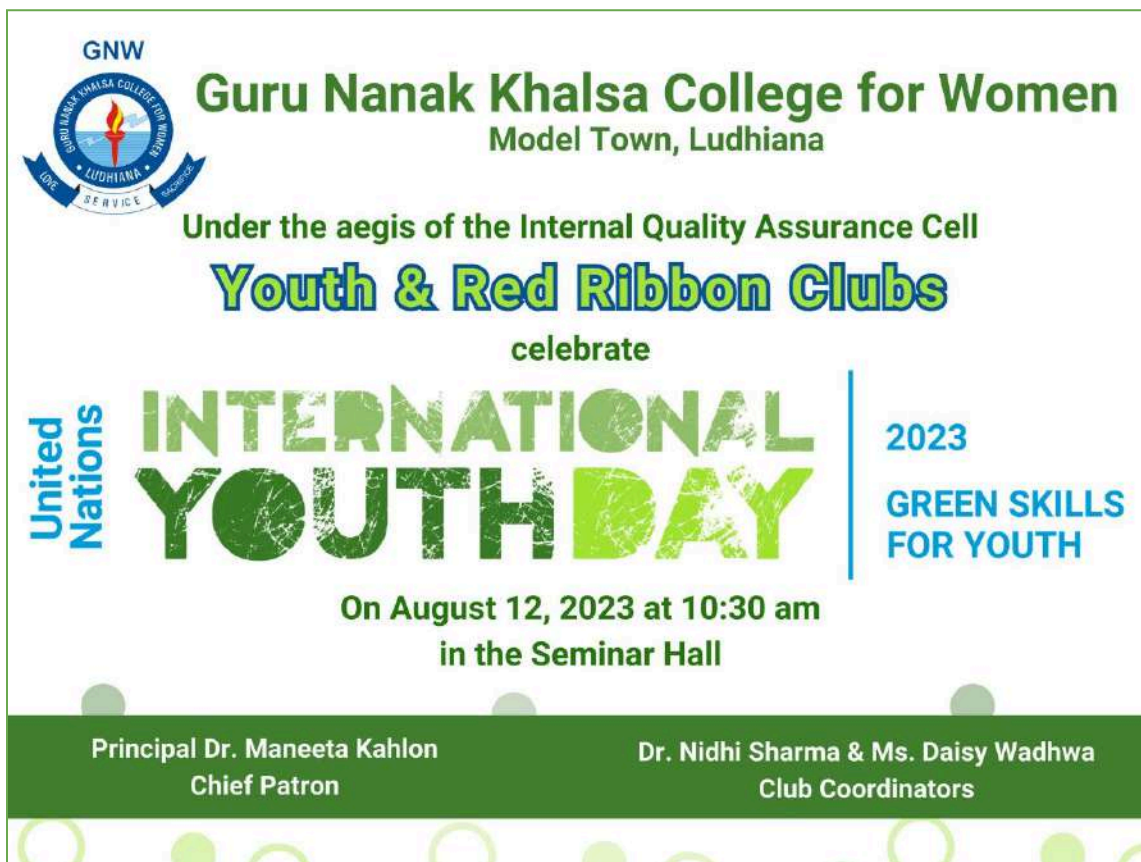
**Activity Details:**

**Activity:** District Level Advocacy Meeting of Red Ribbon Clubs

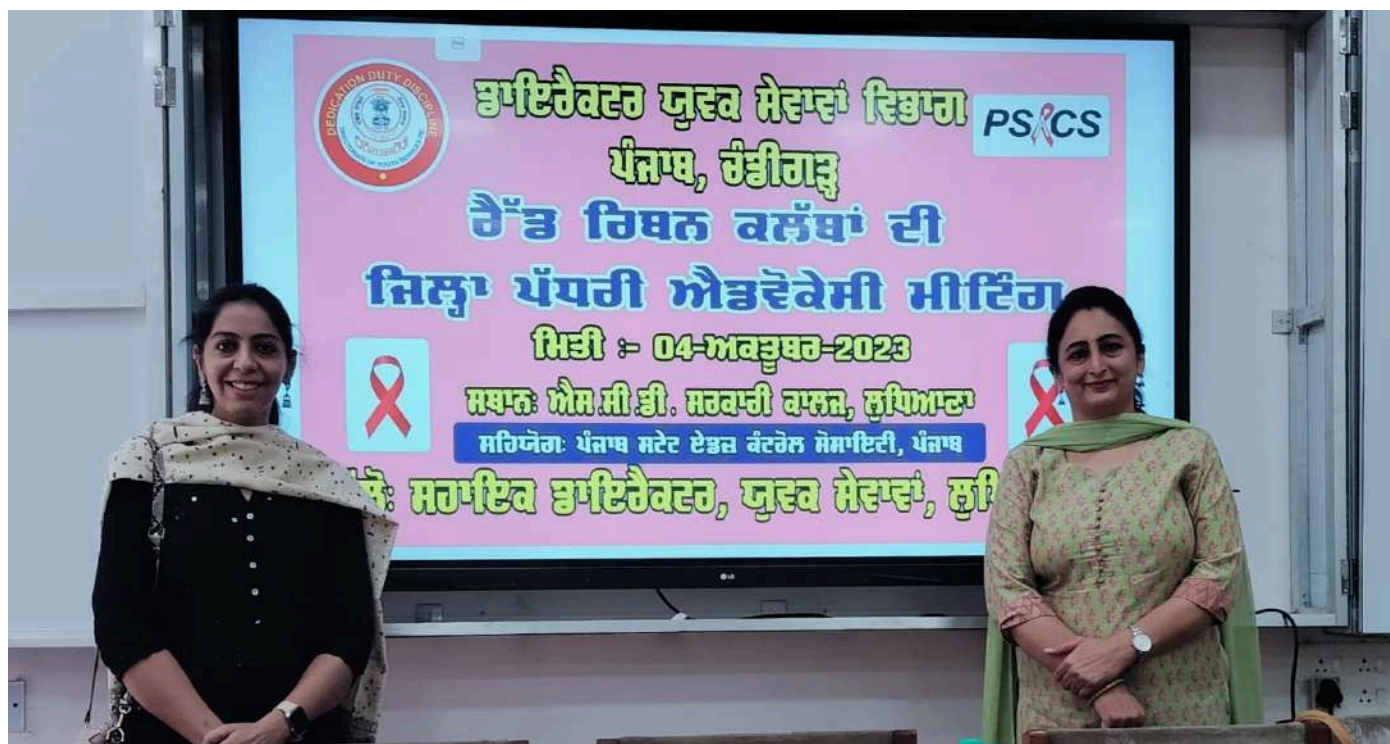
**Activity Details:**

**Activity:** National Cancer Awareness Day

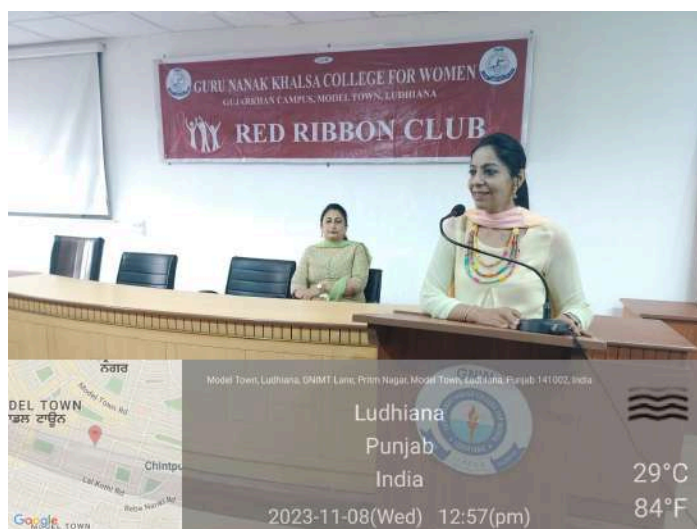
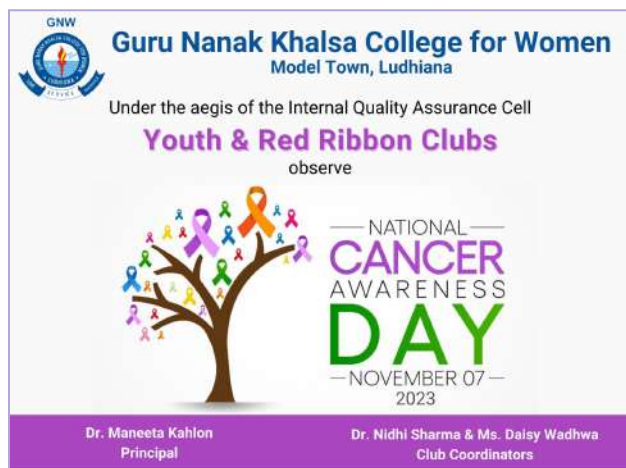
**Activity Details:**
