
Date: January 11, 2024

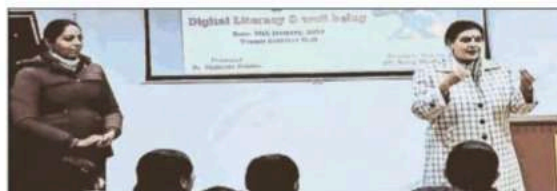

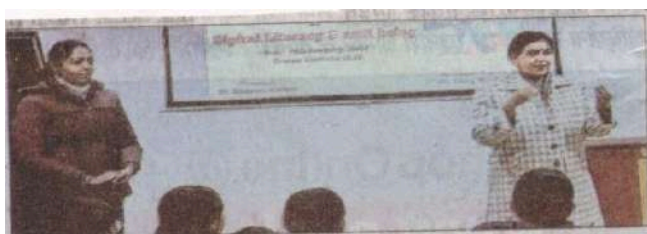

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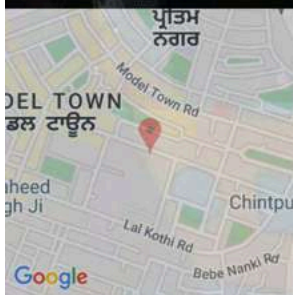

Activity Details: 12 new computers were purchased by the college. These new computers were placed in the computer lab.





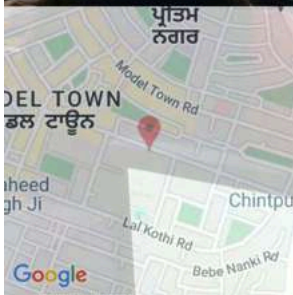
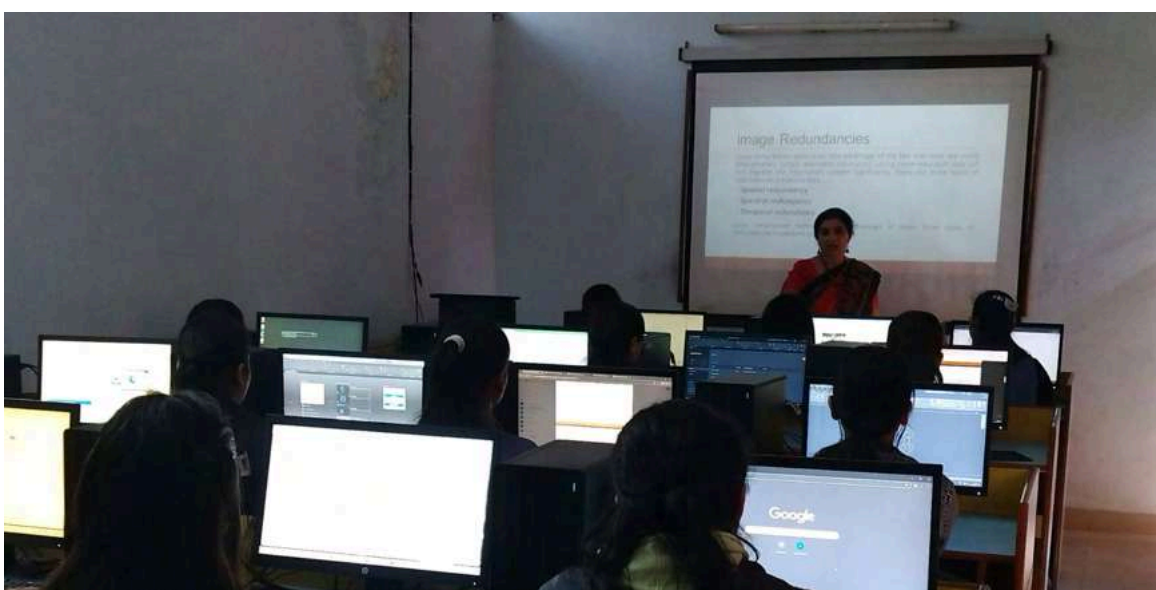


Activity: Workshop on Website Creation using WordPress

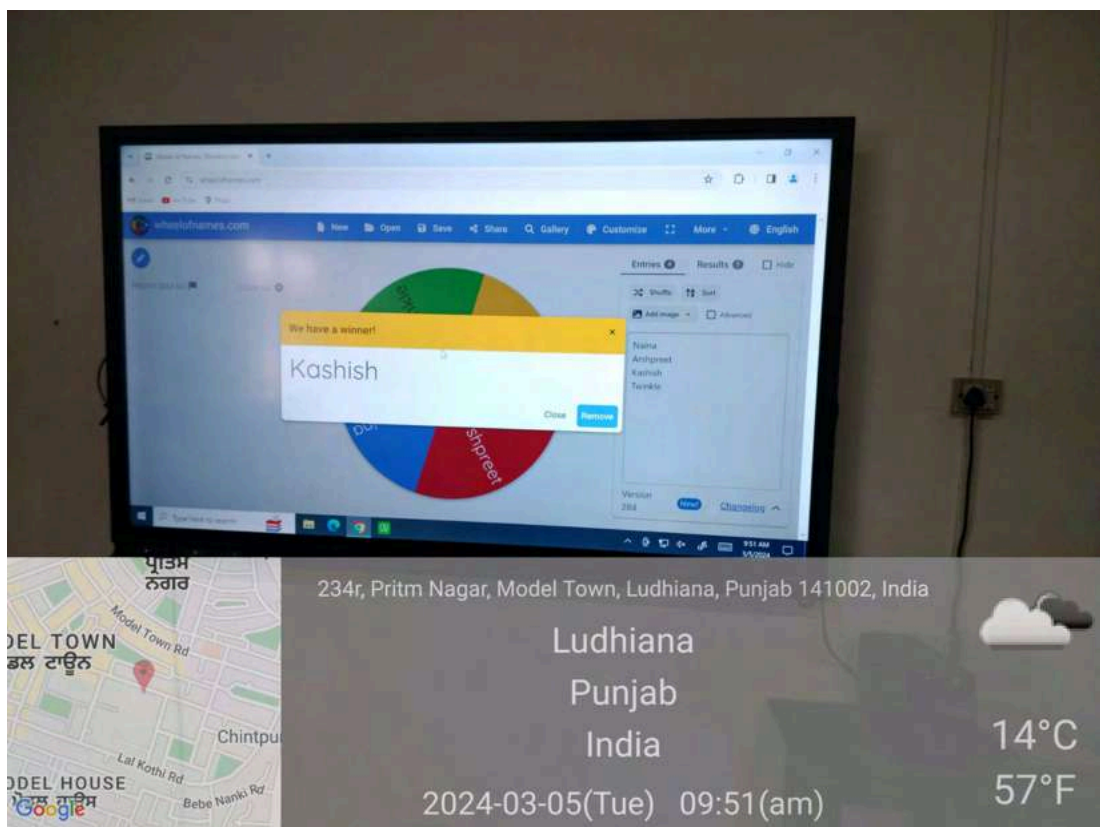


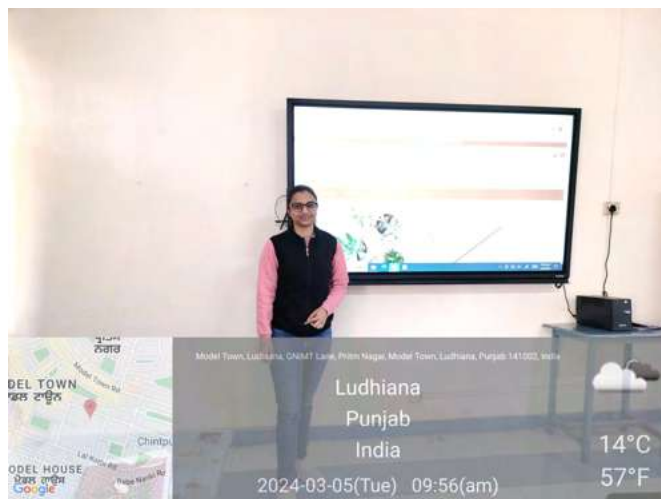
Date: March 5 and March 11, 2024

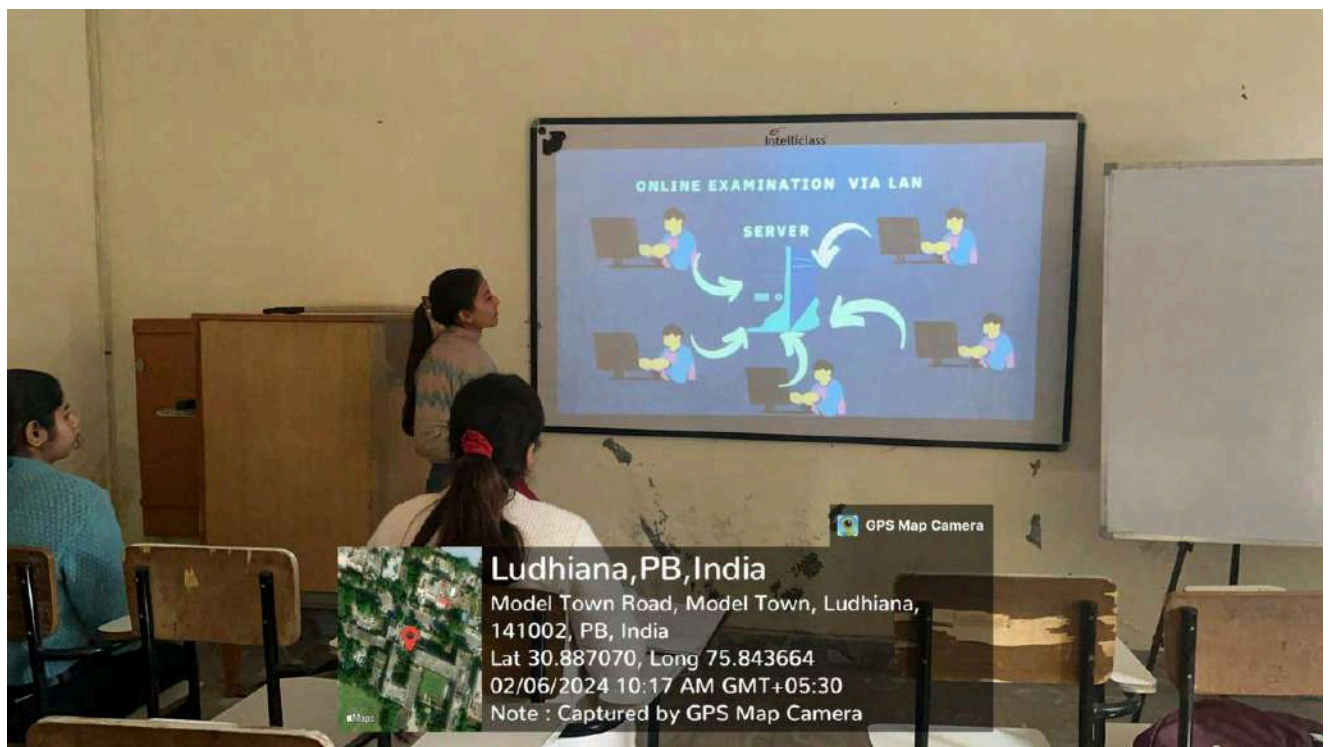


Date: February-March, 2024

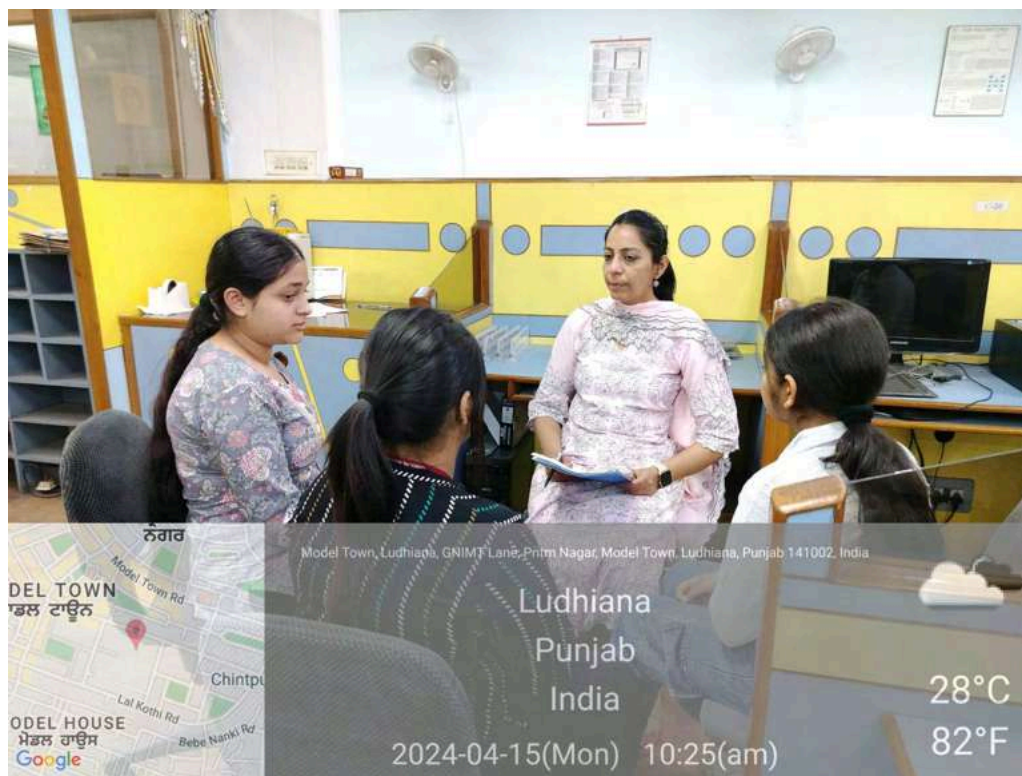




Date: April 15 to April 29, 2024

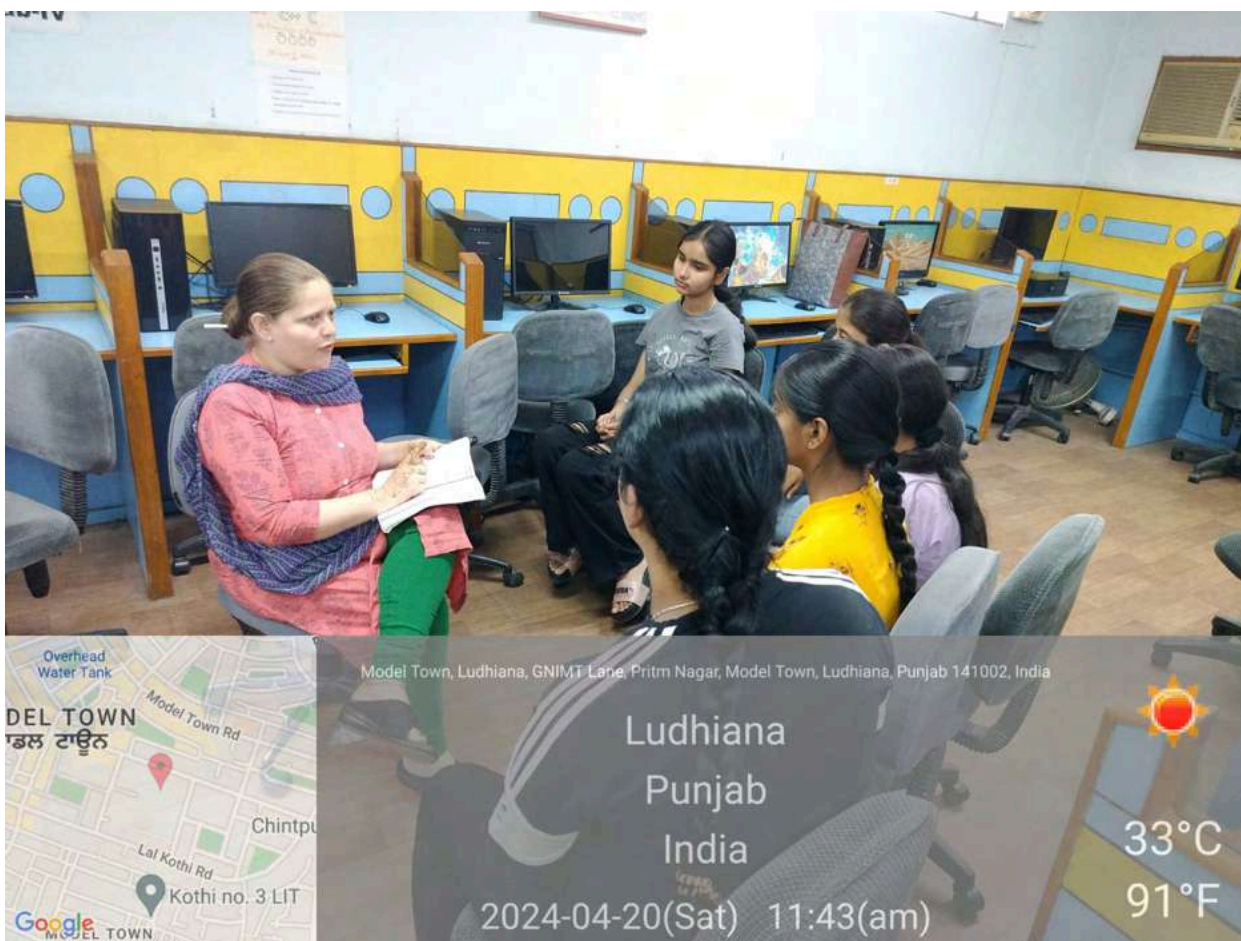




Date: April 16-23, 2024
