SEMINAR DETAILS REPORT ON NATIONAL SEMINAR

“NEP 2020: AN INTERFACE FOR WOMEN ENTERPRISE & FINANCIAL INCLUSION”

Guru Nanak Khalsa College for Women, Gujarkhan Campus, Model Town, Ludhiana conducted National Seminar on **March 16, 2024** in collaboration with Indian Council of Social Science Research, (North-Western Regional Centre, P.U. Chandigarh). The Title of the National Seminar was “**NEP 2020: An Interface for Women Enterprise & Financial Inclusion**”. The seminar highlighted different issues related to NEP and women enterprise like access and completion, quality, relevance, technical and vocational education, training and Challenges related to governance, financing, and quality assurance also impact the efficiency of skills development programs.

Dr. Maneeta Kahlon, College Principal welcomed all the distinguished guests, resource persons and delegates. In her welcome address, Principal Ma'am said that how NEP

introducing different employability skills and soft skills will help to make the girl students stand out from other candidates aiming for the same job with similar academic qualifications. These skills are not clearly illustrated in job descriptions but they are vital to possess in order to secure a role where the employability skills match the job profile. She further said that NEP 2020 acknowledges the importance of gender equality and recognizes that education is a powerful catalyst for change. By prioritizing girls' education and creating an inclusive learning environment, this policy aims to break down barriers and promote equal opportunities for all.

The inaugural session of the seminar commenced with the theme paper presented by **Dr. Kuldeep Kaur**, convener of the seminar. The theme paper highlighted that the National Education Policy, 2020 has conveyed the structural change in the education system which aims to make India the global knowledge superpower ensuring equity and Inclusion. NEP 2020's commitment to gender equality and empowerment sets the stage for transformative change in education. By promoting girls' access to education, providing financial support, addressing disparities in marginalized communities, and empowering girls through the curriculum, we create an environment where every girl can thrive and reach her full potential. While challenges exist, the policy's efforts lay a solid foundation for a more inclusive and equitable education system. After the convener address, **Chief Guest, Prof. (Dr.) Karamjeet Singh, Vice Chancellor, Jagat Guru Nanak Dev Punjab State Open University, Patiala** inaugurated the seminar and addressed the audience. He said that Women empowerment helps boost women's status through literacy, education, training and awareness creation. Furthermore, women's empowerment refers to women's ability to make strategic life choices that were previously denied them. Nations, businesses, communities and groups may benefit from implementing programs and policies that adopt the notion of female empowerment. He also quoted different lines from Guru Granth Sahib Ji highlighting the role of women.

After this, the Guest of Honour, **Mrs. Mridula Jain**, MD, Shingora Textiles Ltd, Ludhiana said that several principles define women's empowerment, such as, for one to be empowered, one must come from a position of disempowerment. They must acquire empowerment rather than have it given to them by an external party. Other studies have found that empowerment definitions entail people having the capability to make important decisions in their lives while also being able to act on them. Empowerment and disempowerment are relative to each other at a previous time; empowerment is a process rather than a product. By giving the description of her own life journey, she motivated the audience with her inspirational talk.

The inaugural address was delivered by **Dr. Monika Aggarwal**, Professor and Director, UIAMS, Panjab University, Chandigarh. She described the outcomes of her research projects undertaken in Panjab University. She highlighted about cultural, social and financial barriers faced by the women entrepreneurs at grassroots level. She said that

NEP will surely give boost to women enterprises in rural areas by providing them education and awareness at primary level.

The Keynote Address was delivered by **Dr. Aman Amrit Cheema**, Director, Professor (Laws), Panjab University Regional Centre, Ludhiana. Addressing the students, she said that woman entrepreneurship which has led to key contribution in economic growth, innovation, and job creation. We all are witness to the journey of efforts, name and fame of acclaimed Indian women entrepreneurs like Indra Nooyi, CEO and Board Chairman of Pepsico etc. She suggested that to promote entrepreneurship amongst the Indian women, concentration should not be on entrepreneurship in education but entrepreneurship education. It is more than teaching entrepreneurial skills but creating a learning environment to transform entrepreneurial idea into action.

After the Keynote Address, Mr. Gurwinder Singh, General Secretary, College Governing Body through his wise words thanked the eminent personalities and urged everybody to take inspiration from their words.

TECHNICAL SESSION

The resource persons for the technical session were Dr. Geeta Bansal, Professor, Centre for Distance & Online Education, Panjab University, Chandigarh, Dr. Sarvjeet Kaur Brar, Former Member, Academic Council, Associate Professor, GHG Harparkash College of Education for Women, Sidhwan Khurd, Distt, Ludhiana, Dr. Nerotma Sharma, Associate Professor, Malwa Central College of Education for Women, Ludhiana, Dr. Satinder Kumar, Assistant Professor, School of Management Studies, Punjabi University, Patiala. Dr. Geeta Bansal as a chairperson of the session presented her views on the key aspects of NEP 2020 and its emphasis on fostering an entrepreneurial spirit among learners. She said that entrepreneurship is not merely about starting businesses; it is about cultivating innovation, resilience, and a mindset of problem-solving. For women, entrepreneurship offers a pathway to economic independence, leadership, and societal impact. NEP 2020 provides the framework for integrating entrepreneurship education into the curriculum, equipping women with the skills, knowledge, and confidence to pursue their entrepreneurial aspirations.

Furthermore, NEP 2020 recognizes the critical link between education and financial inclusion. Financial literacy and inclusion are essential components of empowerment, enabling women to make informed decisions, manage finances effectively, and access financial services. By promoting financial literacy programs and inclusive financial systems, NEP 2020 creates an enabling environment for women to participate in the formal economy, access credit, and invest in their futures.

Dr. Sarvjeet Kaur Brar said that Innovation and entrepreneurship are key drivers of economic growth, social progress, and environmental sustainability in the 21st century. One of the fundamental principles of NEP 2020 for guiding the education system is the nurturance of creativity and critical thinking in learners to harbour innovation. It insists

on that Higher Education must form the basis for knowledge creation and innovation thereby contributing to a growing national economy. HEIs will focus on research and innovation by setting up start-up incubation centres, technology development centres, centres in frontier areas of research, greater industry-academic linkages, and interdisciplinary research including humanities and social sciences. Given the scenario of epidemics and pandemics, it is critical that HEIs take the lead to undertake research in areas of infectious diseases, epidemiology, virology, diagnostics, instrumentation, vaccinology, and other relevant areas. HEIs will develop specific hand holding mechanisms and competitions for promoting innovation among student communities.

Dr. Nerotma Sharma said that the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 in India marks a significant paradigm shift in the education sector, aiming not only for academic excellence but also for holistic development and societal transformation. One of the key aspects of NEP 2020 is its emphasis on fostering entrepreneurship and financial inclusion, particularly among women. The policy recognizes the vital role of women in the economic growth of the nation and endeavour to create an enabling environment for their participation in enterprise and financial activities. At the heart of NEP 2020 lies the recognition of the gender gap prevalent in corporate and business sector. It acknowledges this disparity and seeks to address it through targeted interventions and policy measures. The New Education Policy is a frame work designed by Kasturirangan Committee. After 34 long years, there is a change in the education

Policy in India aiming at universalization of education and making 'India a global knowledge

Superpower'. This broader goal has been visualized in term of ensuring 100% enrolment for girls in schools by 2030 and 50% enrolment in higher education by 2035, decrease gender gaps at all levels, practice gender equity and inclusion in society, and improve the leadership capacity of girls through positive civil dialogues.

Dr. Satinder Kumar elaborated the role of Artificial Intelligence in business world. He said that AI is used in different domains to give insights into user behaviour and give recommendations based on the data, e.g. Google, Netflix, Facebook etc. Real-time data analysis, facilitated by AI, allows marketers to swiftly adjust strategies in accordance with market fluctuations. The integration of AI in data analysis can help optimize campaigns, increase customer engagement, and yield enhanced results. Beyond enabling consumer insight generation, AI will be able to identify, capture, and predict future trends. By studying and analyzing social media content, AI "can have a more accurate prediction of consumers' tastes, preferences, and needs, and how these indexes may change in the future.

The house was open for discussion and queries followed by the Remarks of Chairperson Dr. Geeta Bansal.
