



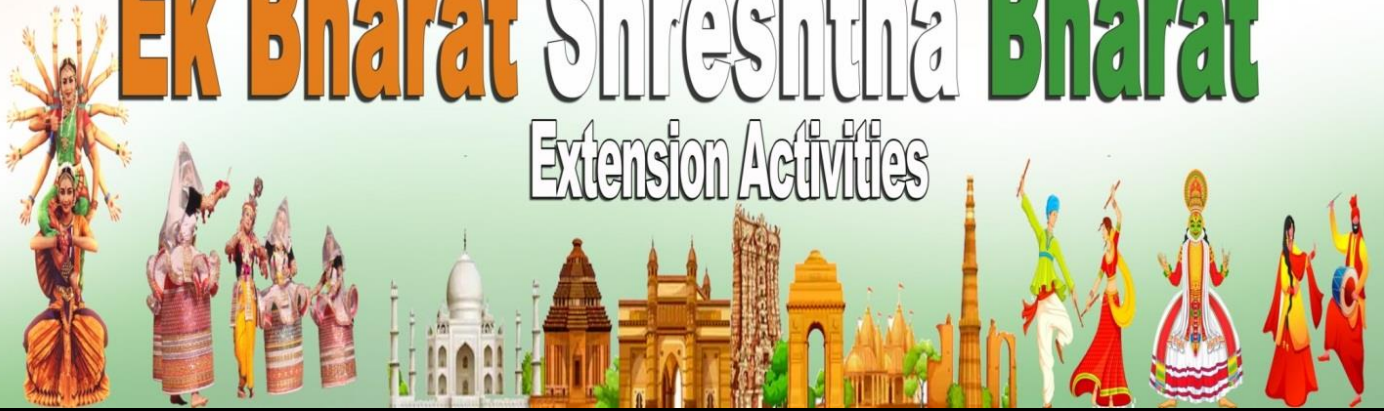

A Tree Plantation cum plan distribution drive was organized on August 09, 2023 as a part of the Gram Sabha agenda of the village Bhila. The drive commenced with the plantation of saplings by the area councilor along with the local of the village community.

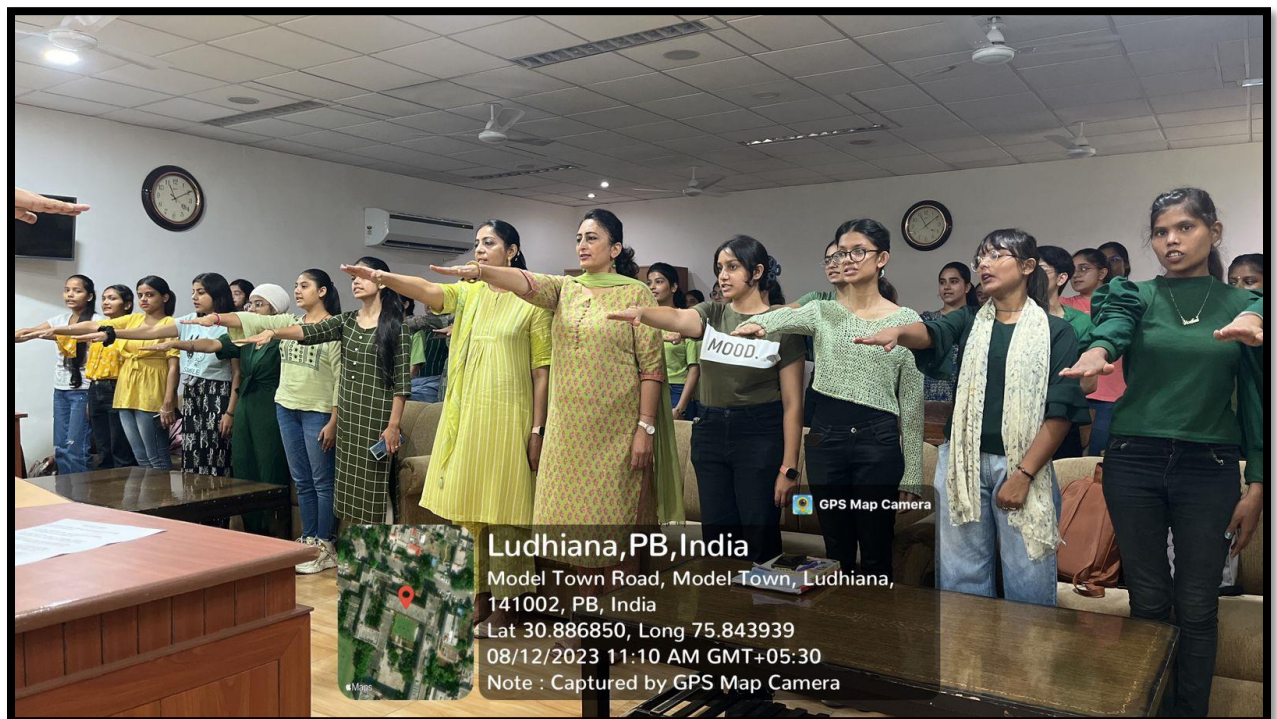

- NSS Unit in collaboration with Department of Music sang Maati Anthem with full enthusiasm to mark Independence Day celebrations on August 14, 2023.

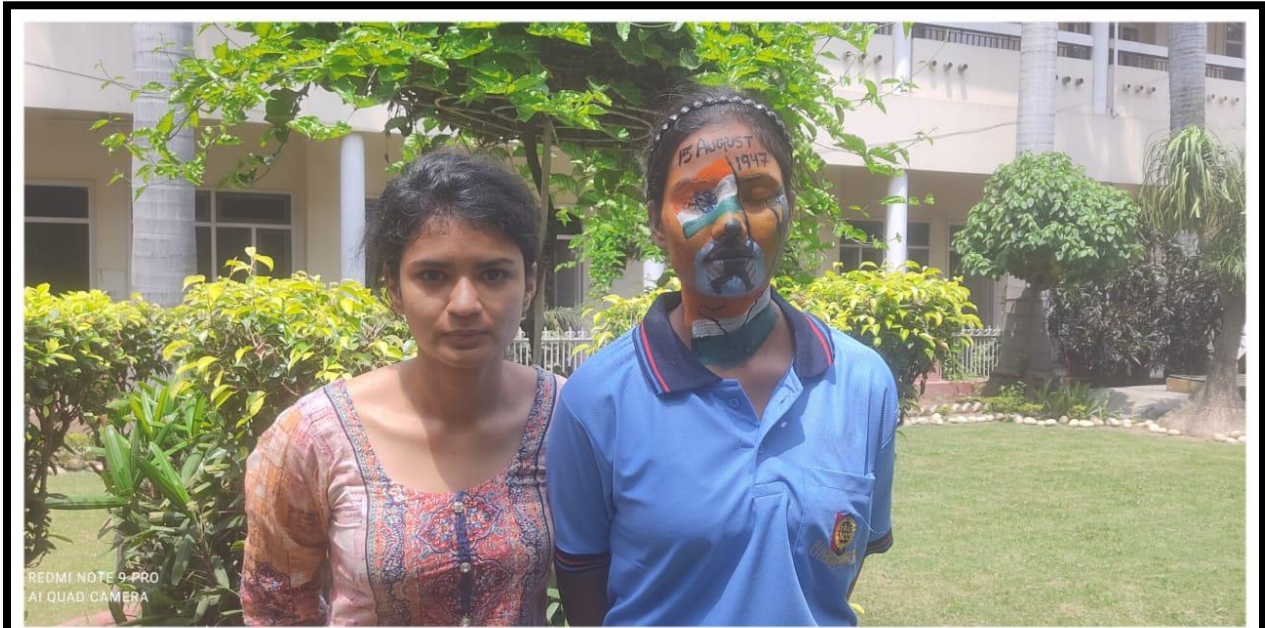

1. Youth Talent Show organized at GNKCW

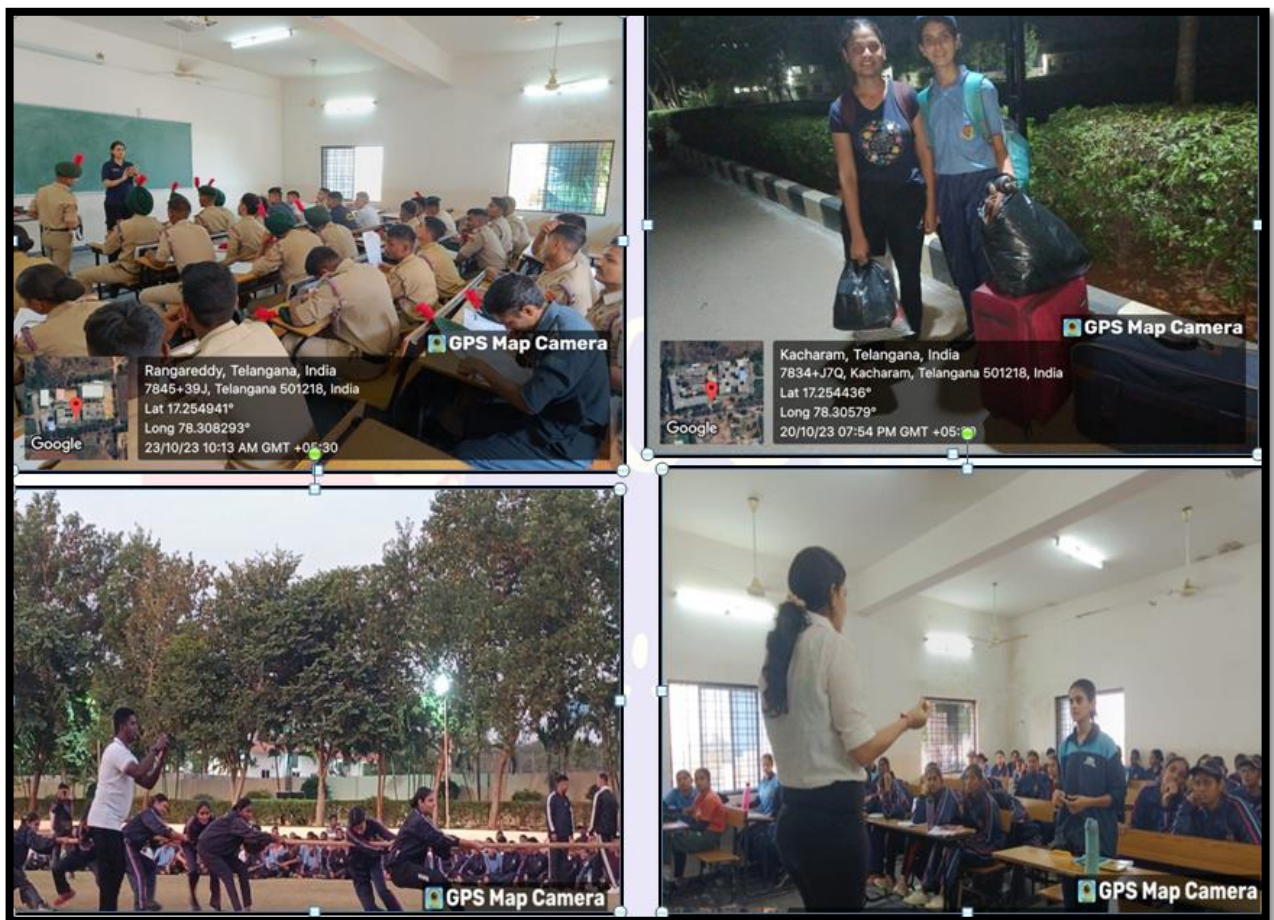
