# 2. Participated in Quiz Competition








## 3. Integrate and Encourage Yoga through Life pledge






## **11.National Sports Day**






The theme of the Second week of September (From September 09-15) is to find out the degree of malnutrition and to fight back the symptoms by introducing millet meals.




The theme of the Third week of September (From September 16-25) fights nutritional deficiencies and advancement of diet through millets.

Principal Dr Maneeta Kahlon motivated the students to follow the foot steps of Bhai Ghanaiya ji






## 14.Gandhi Jayanti
