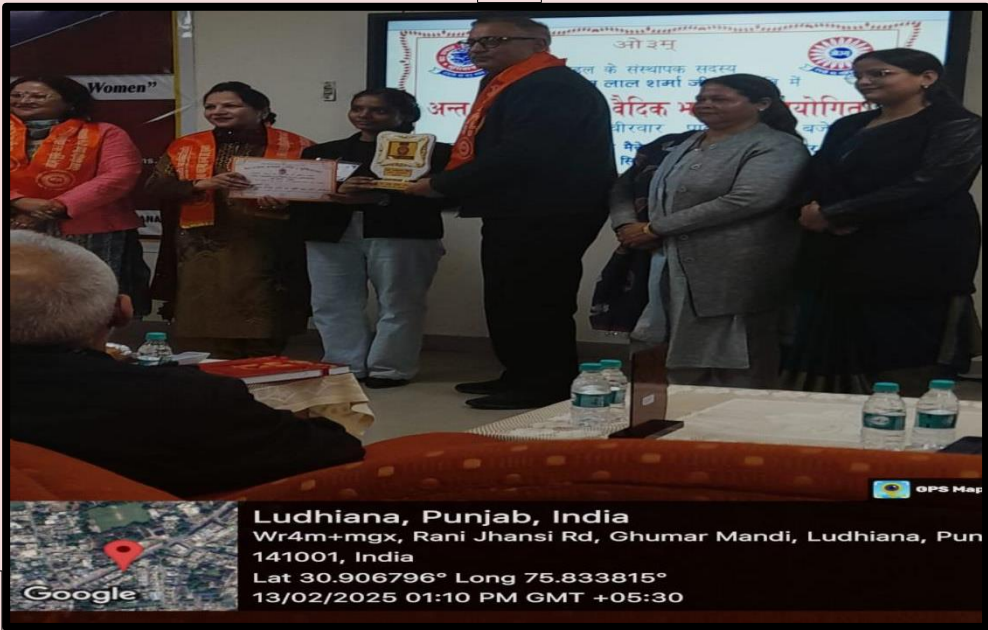
ACTIVITY: Inter-College Declamation Competition organized by Ved Prachar Mandal

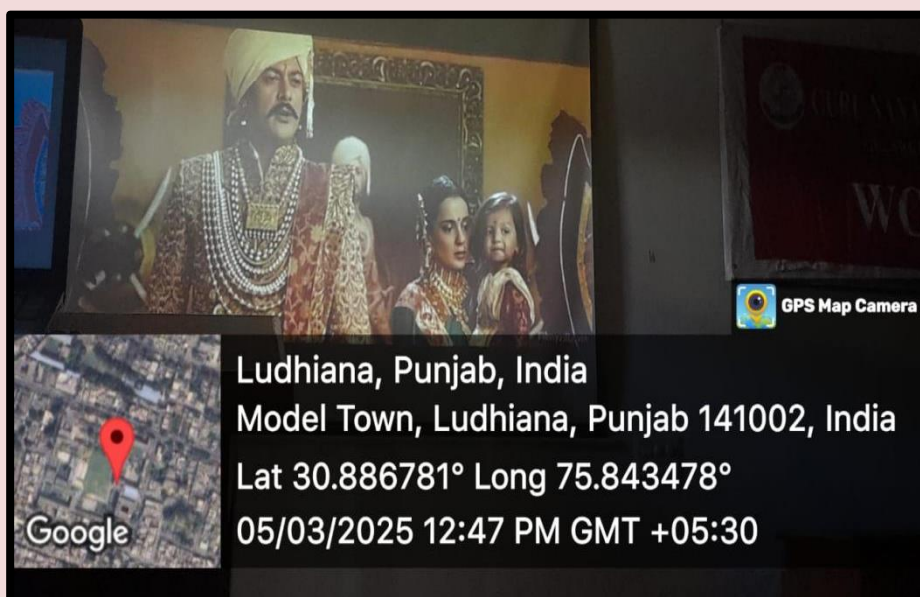

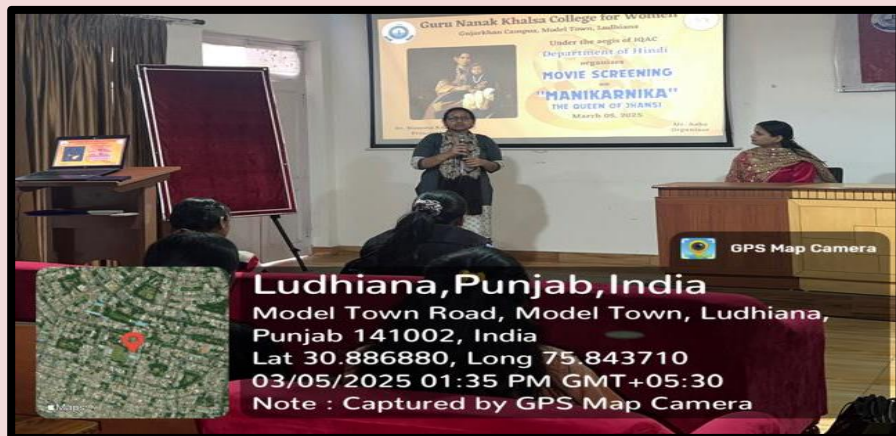
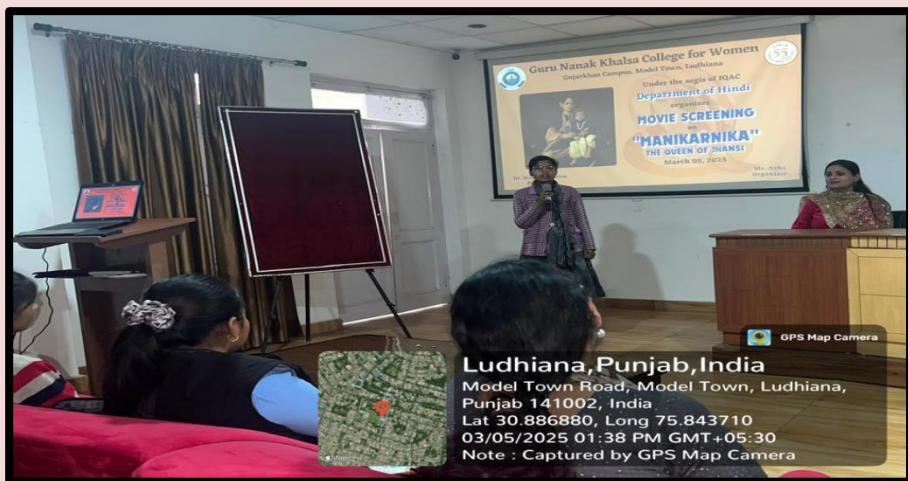
