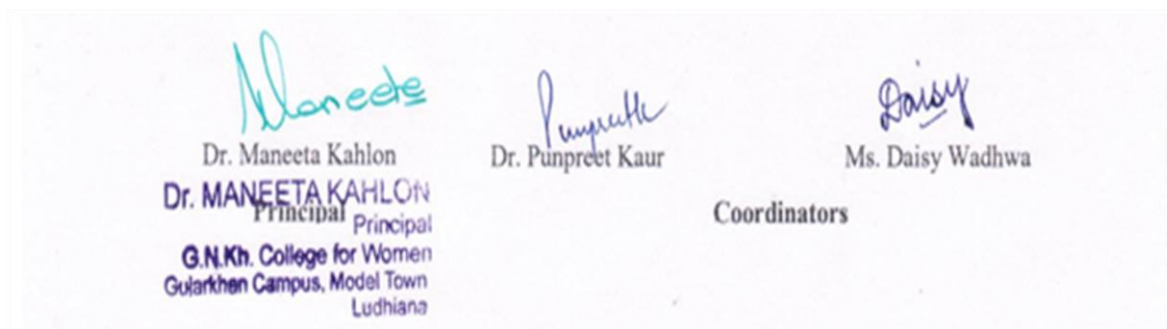

Planning Meeting for Panjab University Zonal Youth and Heritage Festival Held at GNKCW

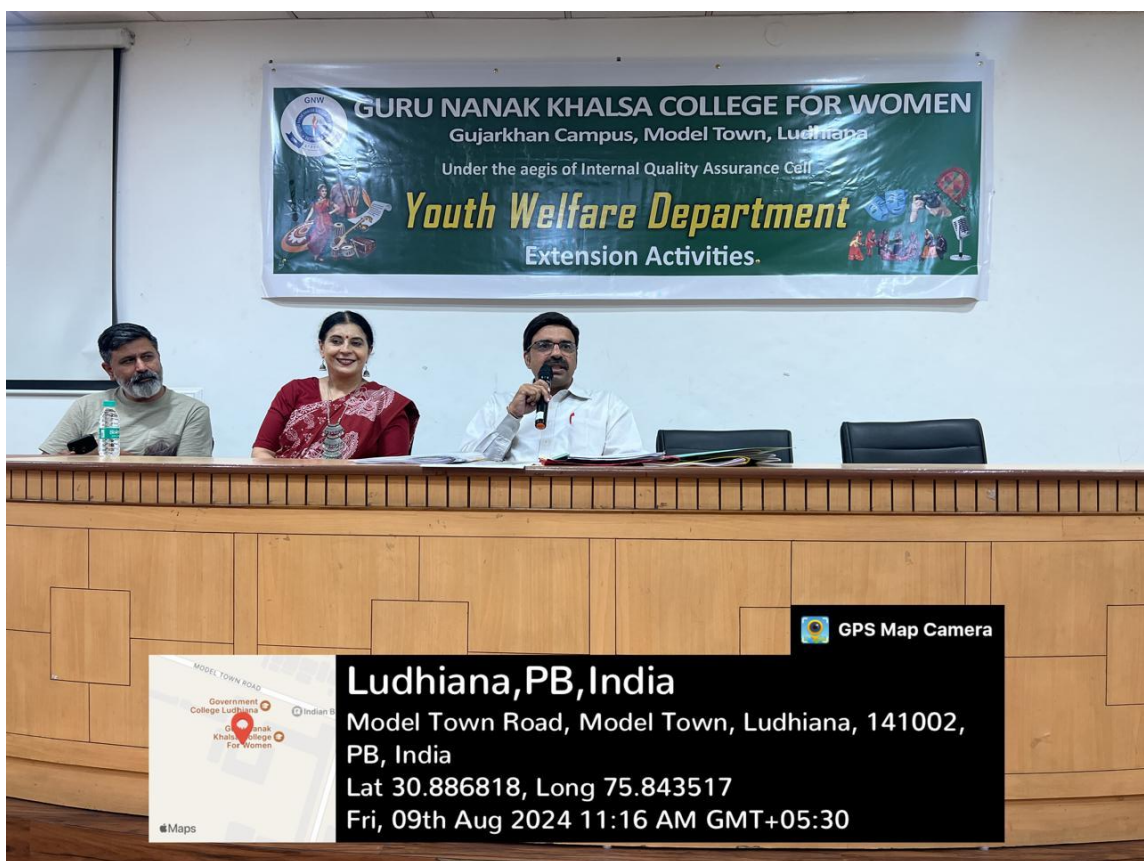

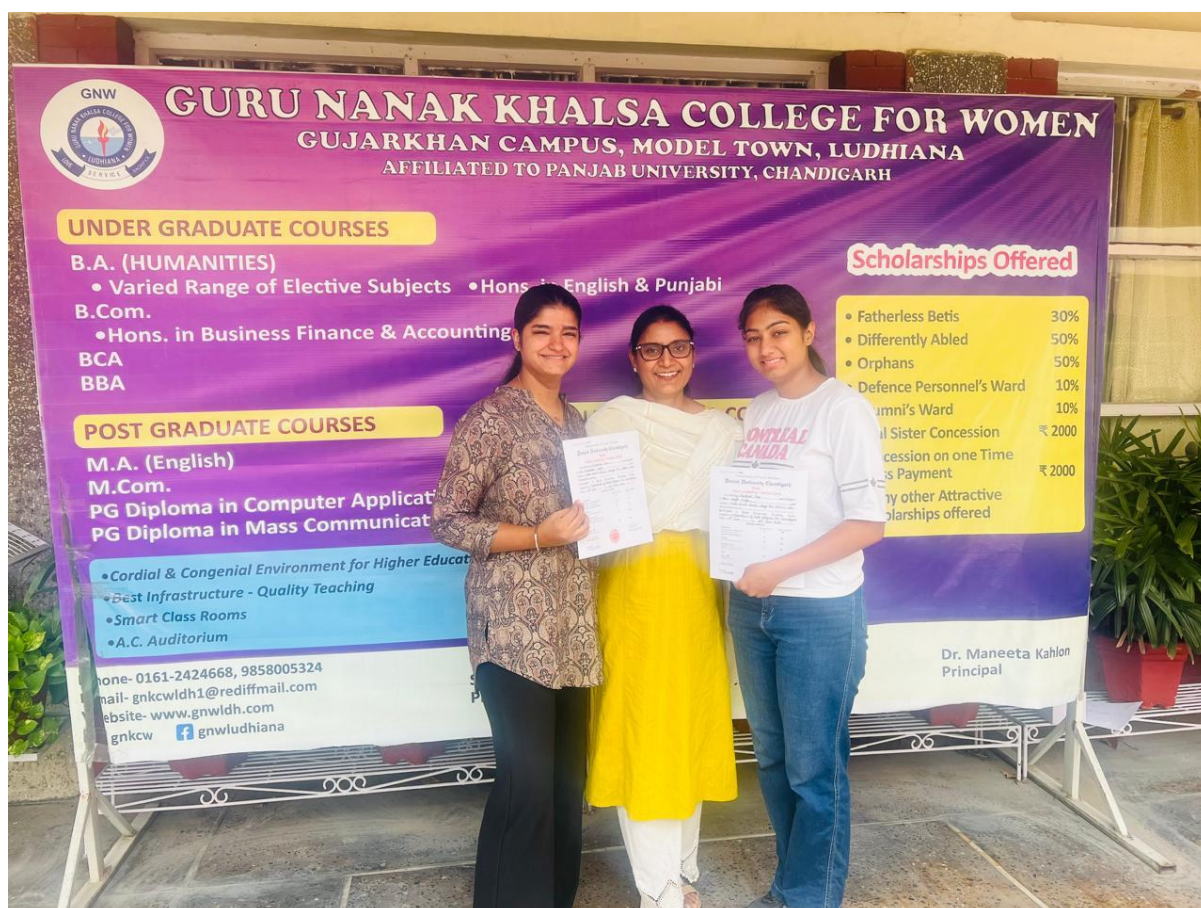
Dr. Maneeta Khalon, Principal of the college, appreciated the students for their outstanding performance and adaptability skills, congratulating them on their achievements.









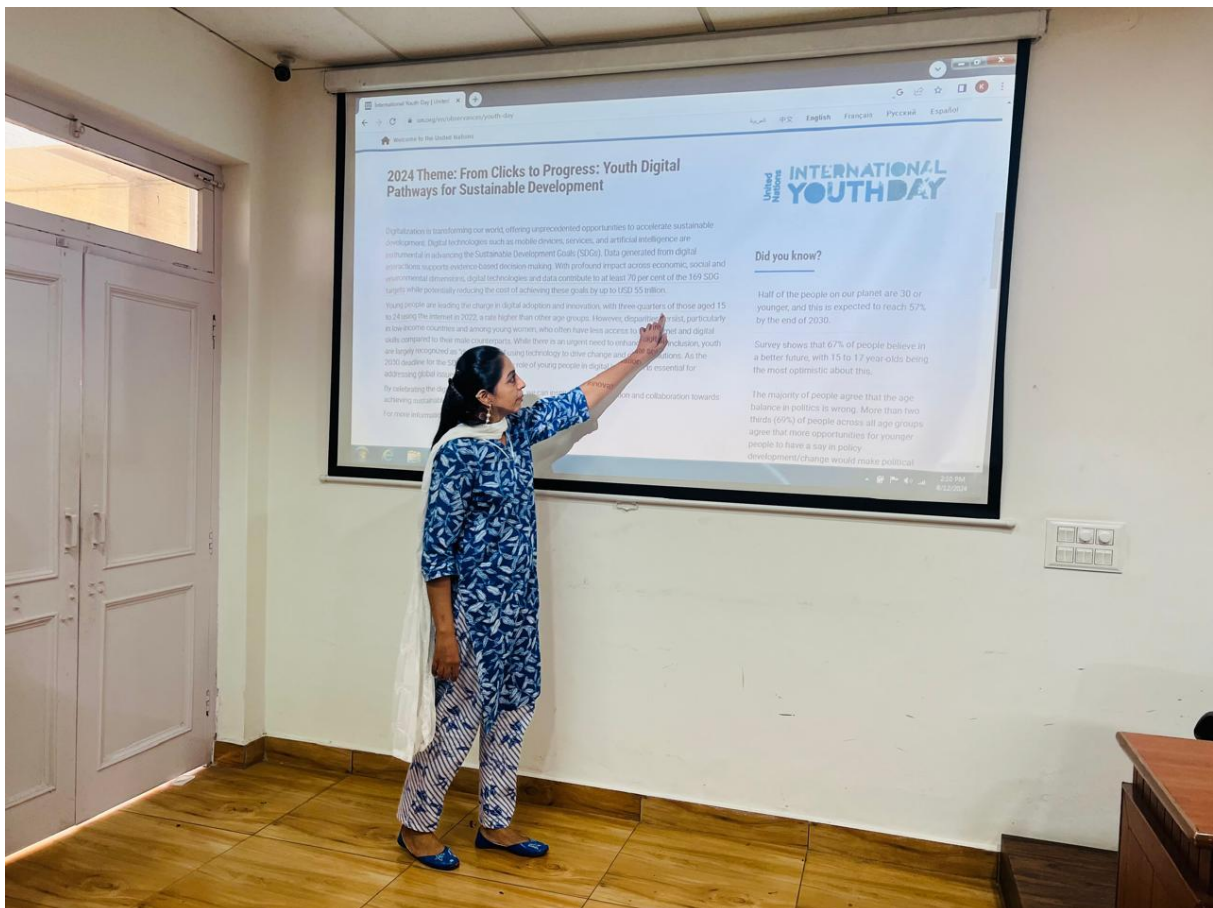


International Youth Day

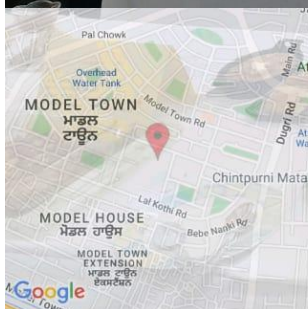


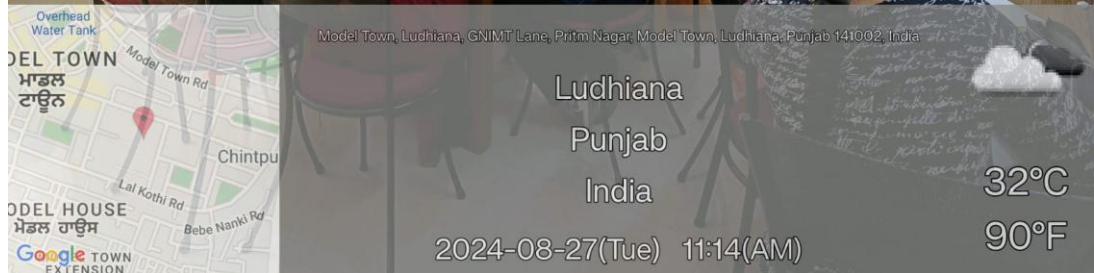


Talent Hunt Competitions

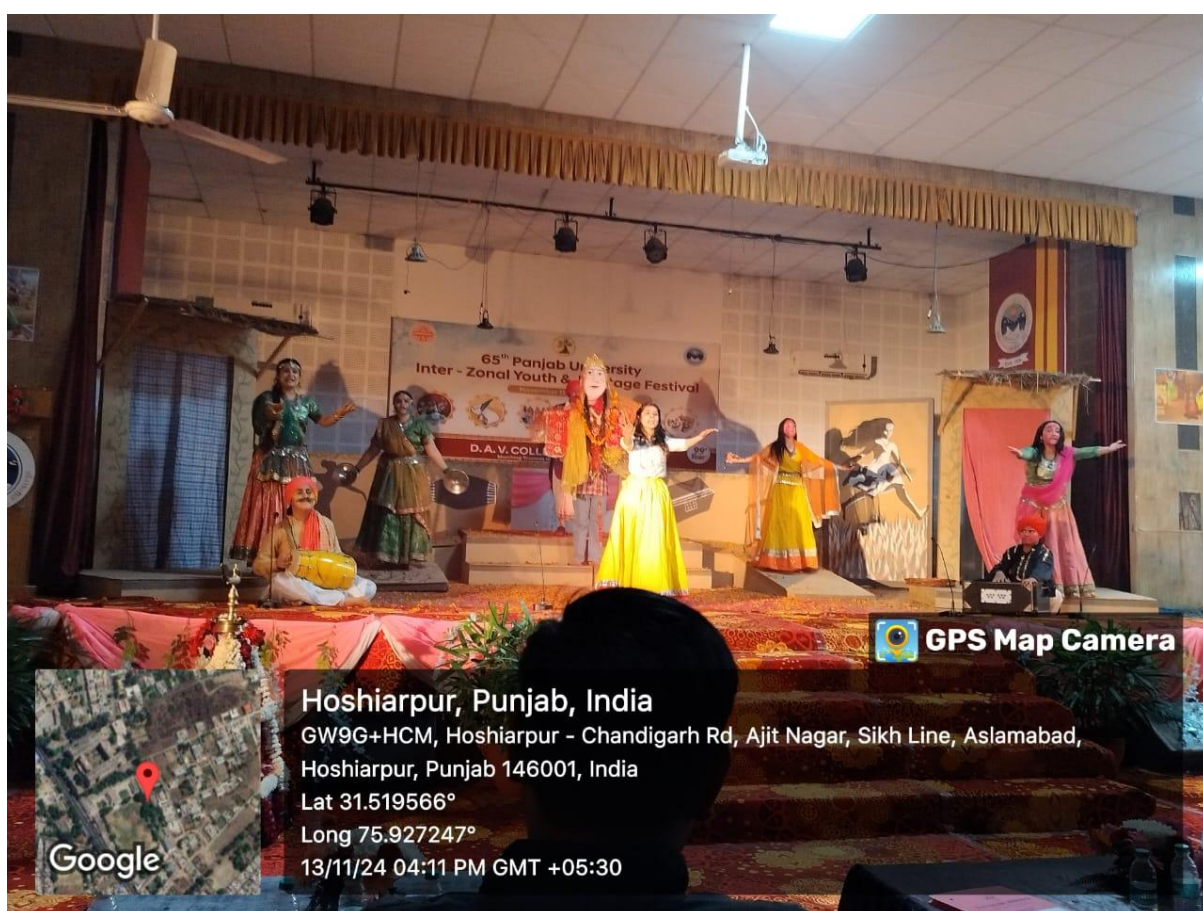
Panjab University Inter-Zonal Youth and Heritage Festival

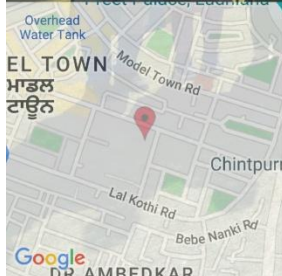


National Voter's Day

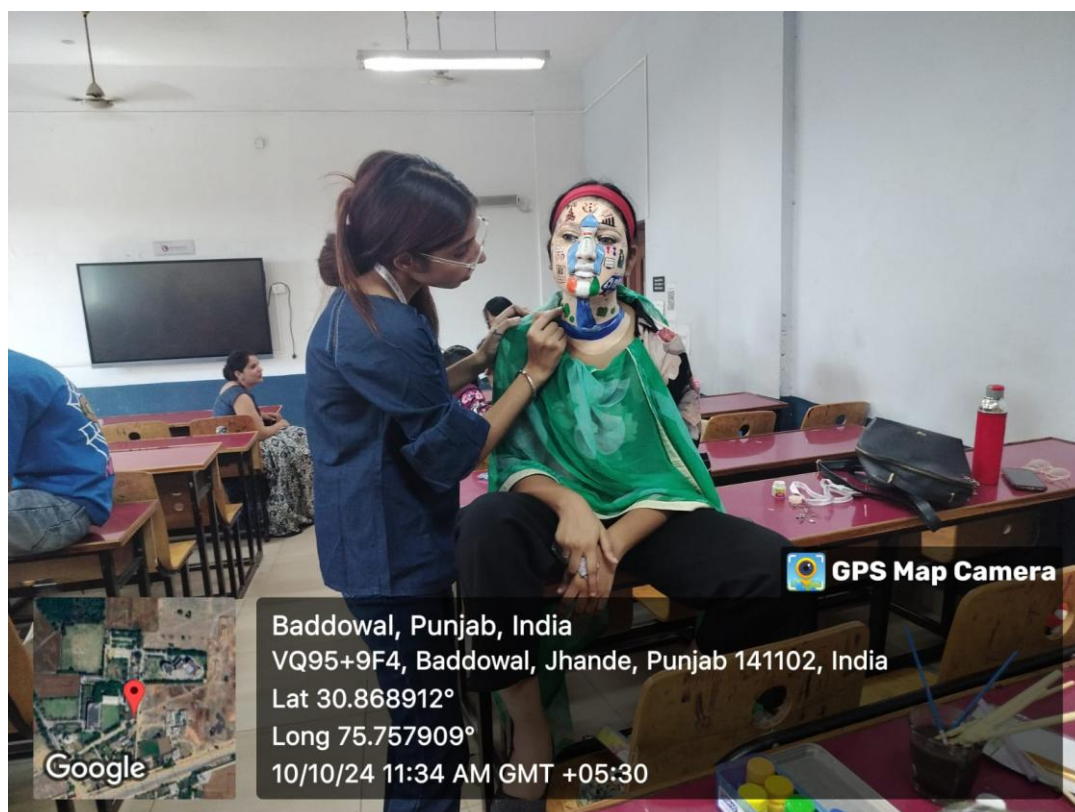

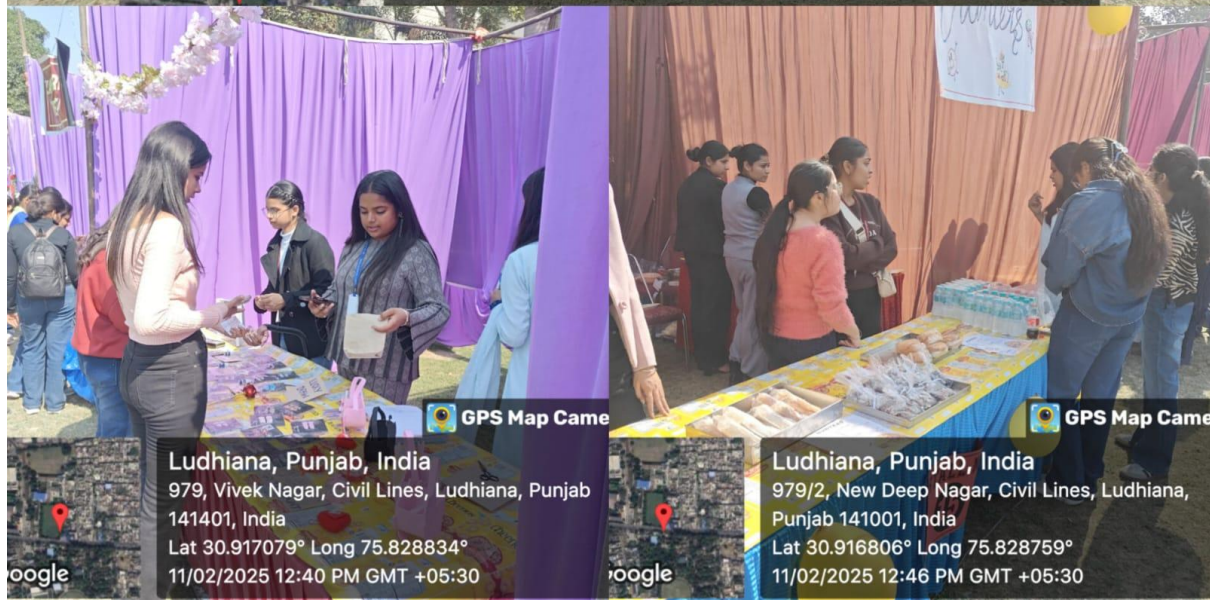
