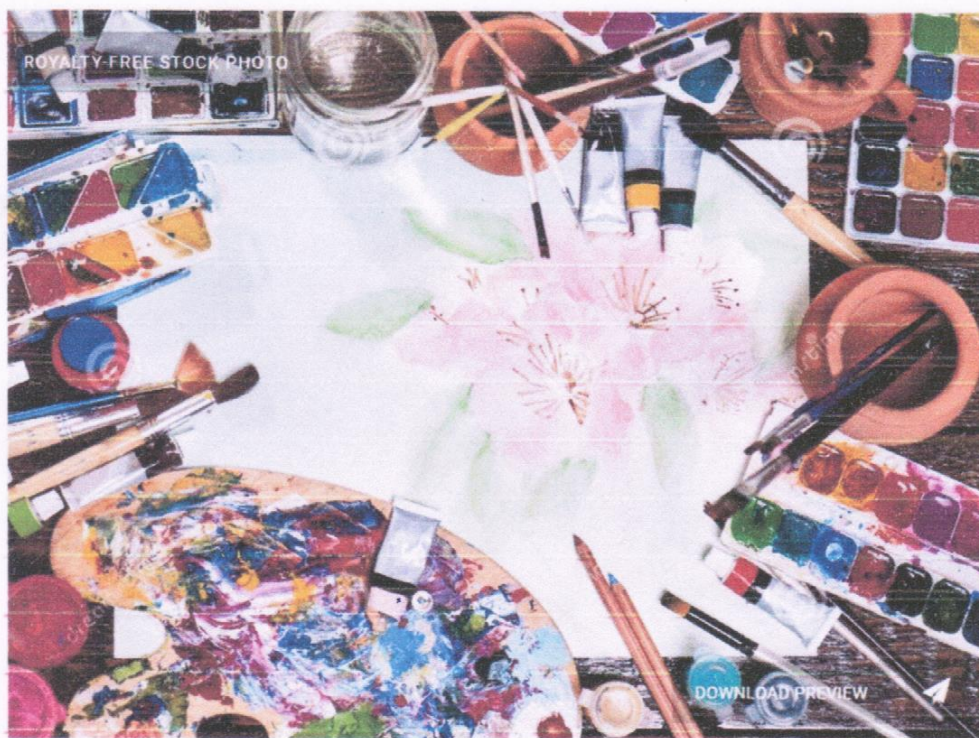

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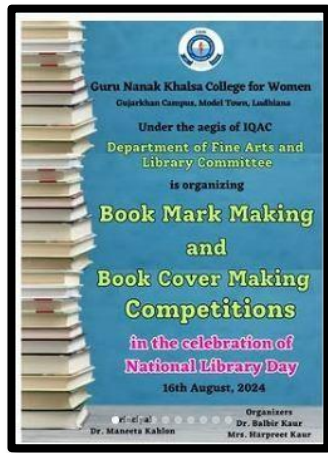
3. Inter Class Book cover and Book mark making Competition

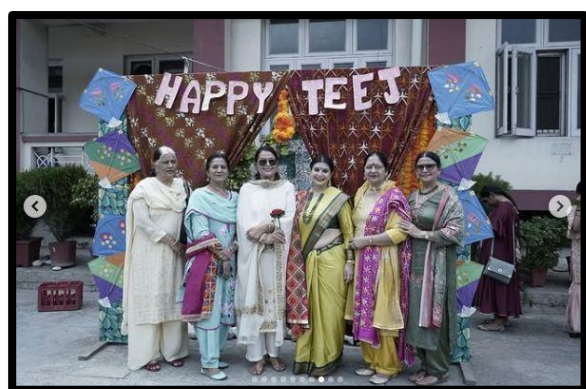




5. Decoration on Teej Festival

Panjab University Inter-Zonal Youth and Heritage Festival is being held at DAV College, Hoshiarpur from November 11-14, 2024.

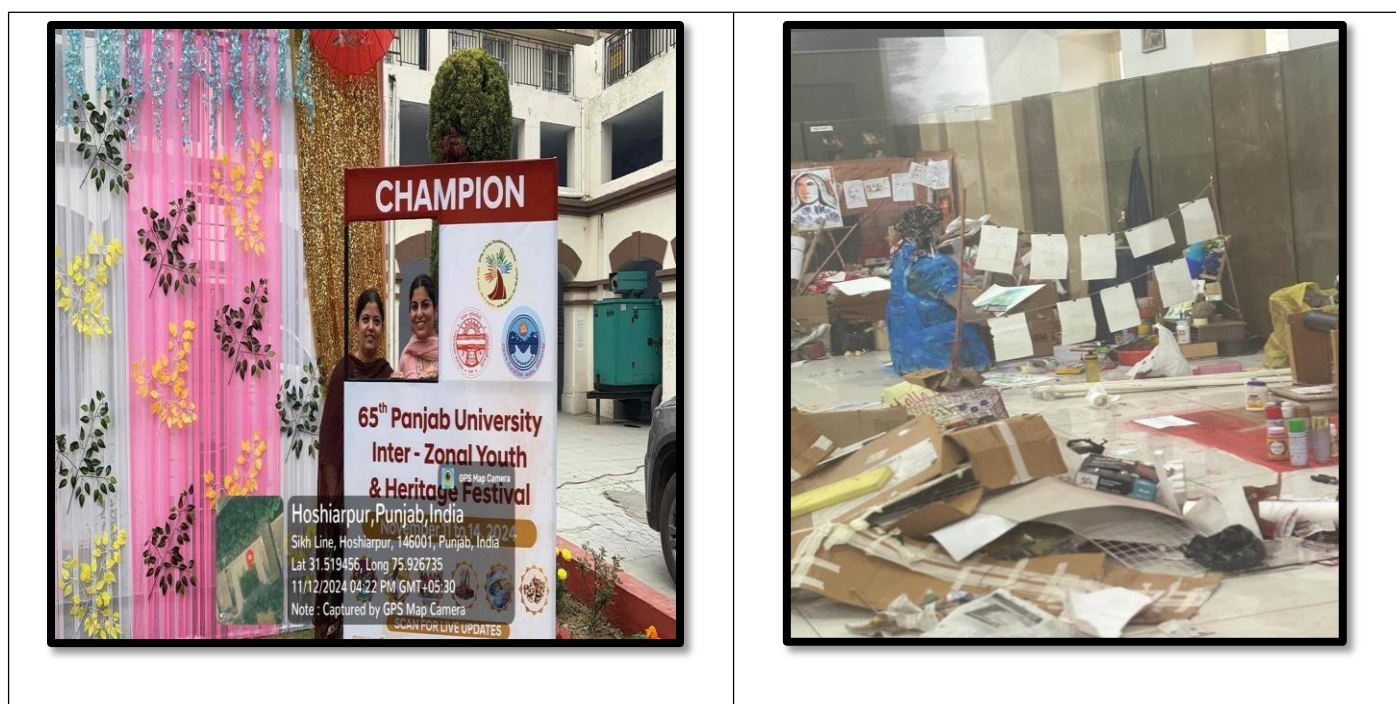
