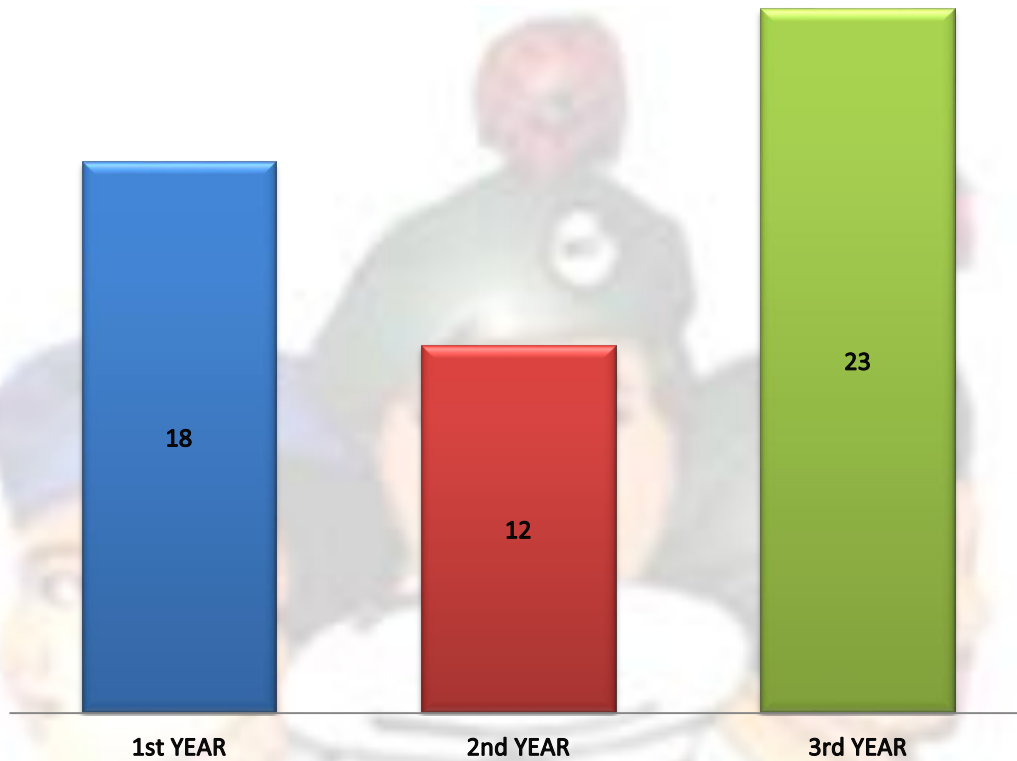

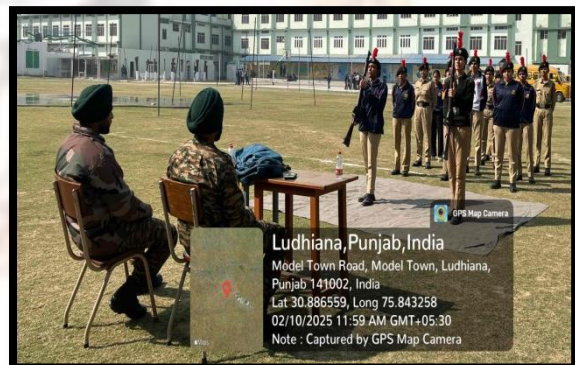
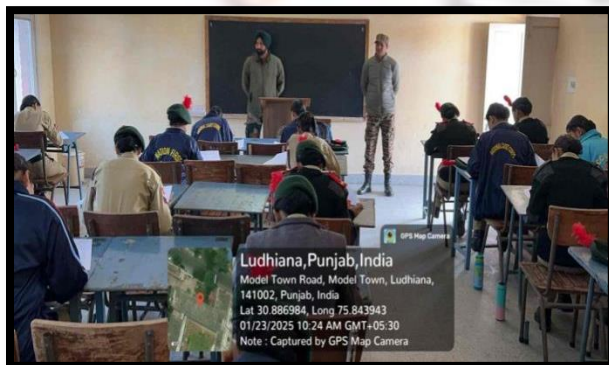

Activity- National Voters' Day

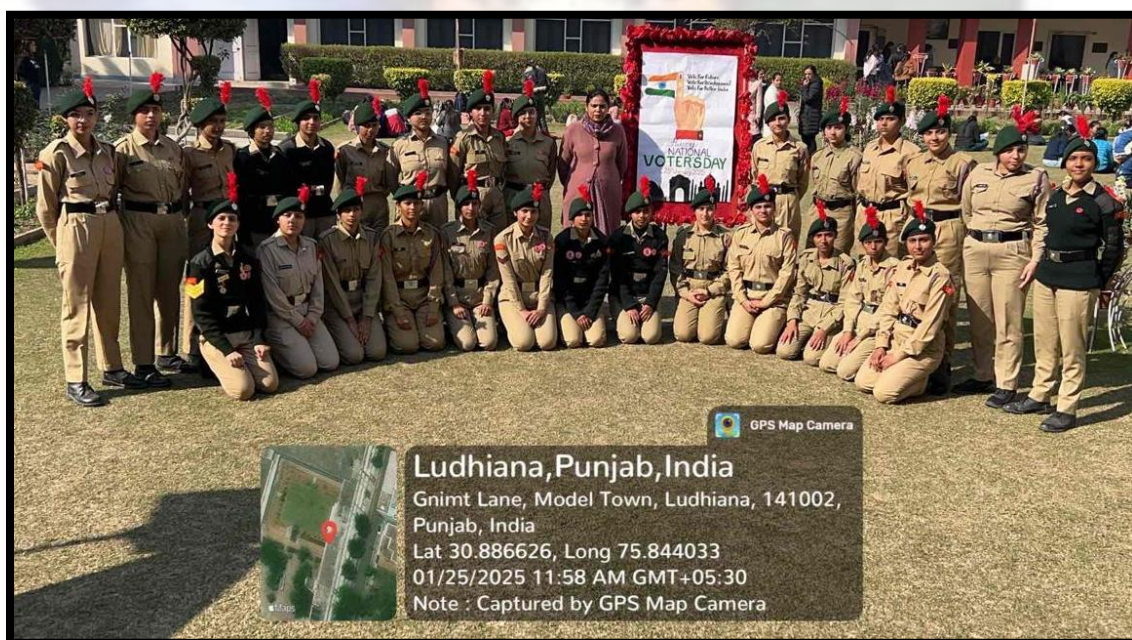

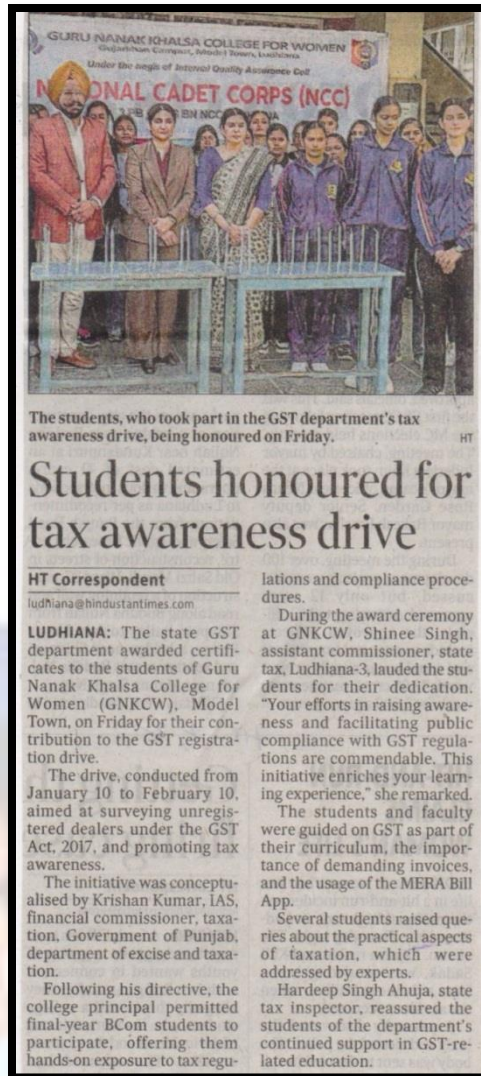

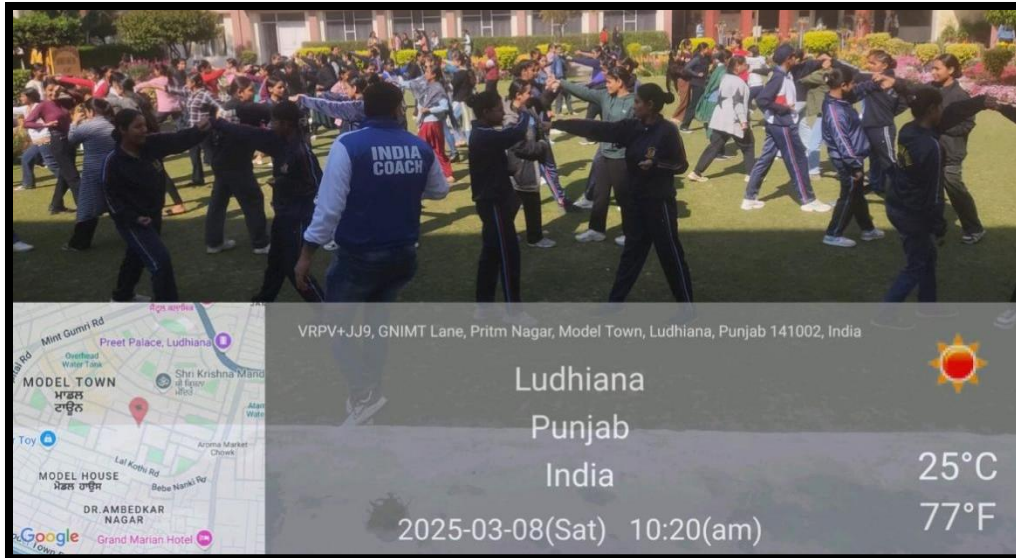
discussions on mental preparedness.

The workshop successfully empowered participants, enhancing their ability to respond effectively in potential self-defense scenarios.

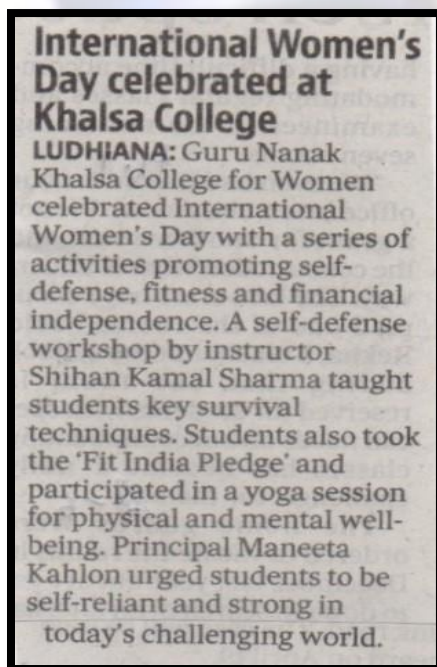
Principal Dr. Maneeta Kahlon graced the event and encouraged students to undergo physical training in self-defense, enabling them to handle any unwanted situation with confidence.

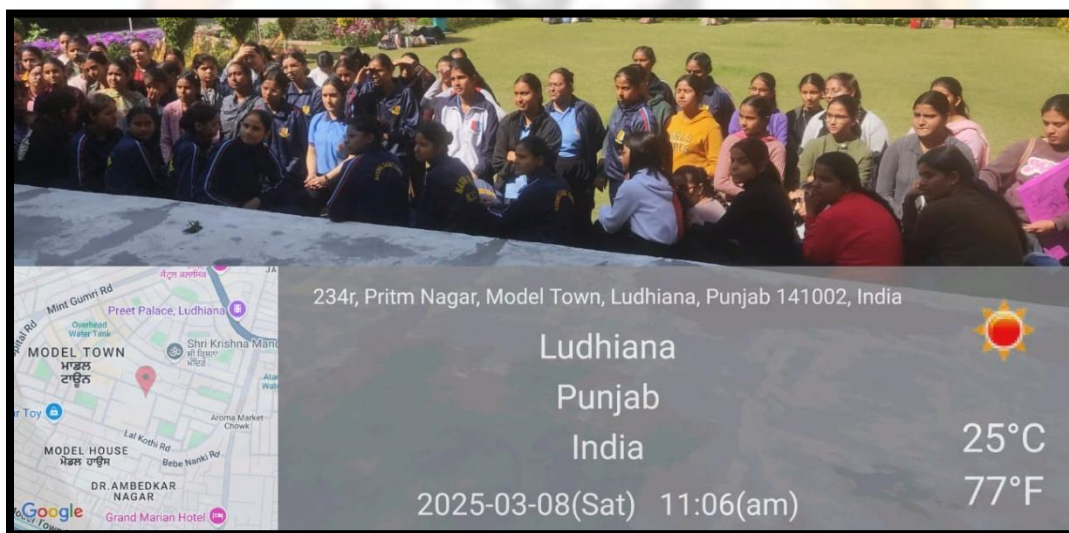


7. **Date-** March 8, 2025

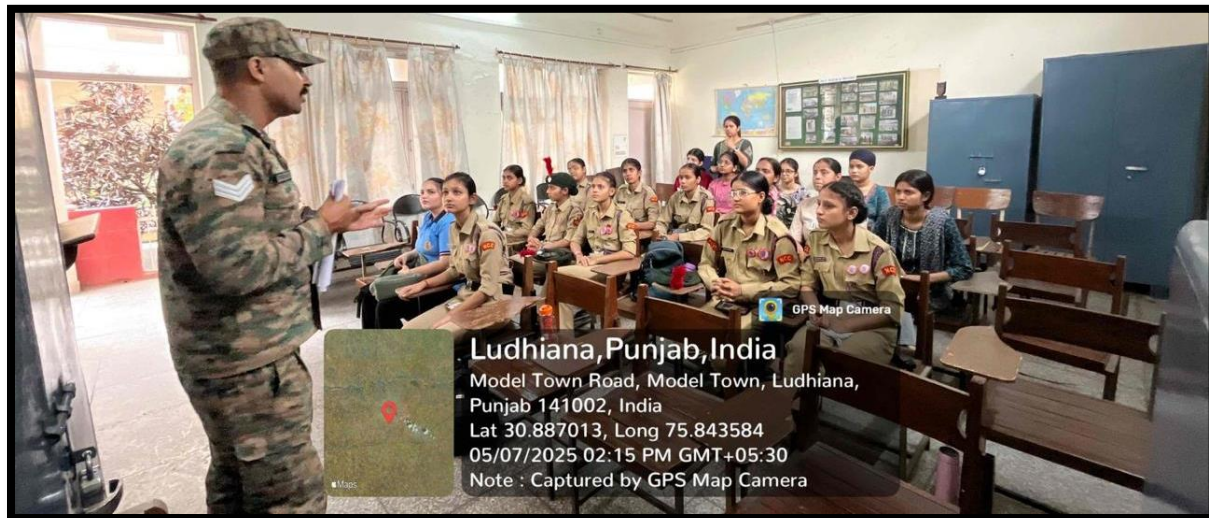
10. Date- 7th May, 2025

Activity- Observed World No Tobacco Day

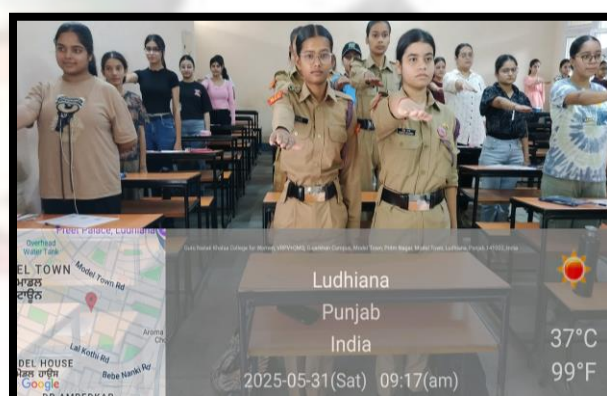
