# MORNING SESSION Physical exercise:

The fifth day of the NSS Camp began with a morning session of physical exercise, where NSS volunteers actively participated in various fitness activities. These exercises aimed to enhance physical well-being, promote a healthy lifestyle, and instill the importance of regular physical activity in their daily lives. The session was guided by trained instructors, ensuring that the participants performed the exercises correctly and efficiently. The enthusiasm and energy displayed by the volunteers set a

positive tone for the rest of the day.

### Maghi Sangrand celebrations:

Following the exercise session, the volunteers, along with the NSS coordinators, visited a nearby Gurdwara to partake in the Maghi Sangrand celebrations, a significant Sikh festival observed to mark the beginning of the month of Magh. The students participated in spiritual activities, including listening to kirtan (devotional hymns) and collective singing. They also engaged in prayer and seva (selfless service) as part of the celebration. The visit provided an opportunity for the volunteers to reflect on the values of humility, devotion, and community service, which are central to the spirit of NSS.

#### **Meditation session:**

A special meditation session was conducted to promote mental well-being and holistic health among the students. The session was led by Kunwar Ranjan, a renowned Mind & Meditation Expert, Happiness & Wellness Coach, and Founder of Vasudhaiv Kutumb Pariwar. He guided the volunteers through techniques aimed at relieving stress, calming the mind, and fostering positivity. Kunwar Ranjan emphasized the importance of living in the present moment and provided strategies to help students let go of their past and embrace a stress-free life.

The session also featured a lecture by Acharya Dr. Lokesh Sharma, the Founder of the Nature Veda Health Institute, Ludhiana, and a prominent figure in the field of naturopathy and Ayurveda. Dr. Sharma holds several distinguished positions, including:President, Sahara Charitable Trust,Incharge, Naturopathy Ayurveda Panchkarma Department at Rehbar Hospital and Medical College, Bhawanigarh, Punjab.

Dr. Sharma delivered an insightful talk on the principles of Ayurveda, explaining key concepts such as Vata, Pitta, Kapha, which represent the three fundamental doshas (body types or energies) in Ayurveda. He also introduced the students to the Ayurvedic principles of Chhad Ras (six tastes) and Katu Ras (pungent taste), elaborating on their significance in maintaining physical and mental balance. He highlighted how understanding these concepts can help individuals lead healthier and

more harmonious lives.

The session provided an enriching experience for the students, blending traditional Ayurvedic wisdom with modern stress-relief techniques. It was highly appreciated by the participants, who felt rejuvenated and inspired to incorporate these practices into their daily lives.

#### **EVENING SESSION**

#### **Art and Craft Workshop:**

On the evening of Day 5 of the NSS Camp at Guru Nanak Khalsa College for Women, Ludhiana, a creative and engaging Art and Craft Workshop was conducted by Mrs. Balwinder Kaur, a faculty member from the Department of Fine Arts.
