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CHAPTER 2

Nurturing Resistance: Environmental and Social Oppression in Mahashweta Devi's "Seeds"

Gagneet Pal Kaur

Bitter Soil by Mahasweta Devi is a collection of four short stories namely, "Little Ones", "Seeds", "Witch" and "Salt". To quote her words, "So the sole purpose of my writing is to expose the many faces of the exploiting agencies: The feudal-minded landowner, his henchmen, the so-called religious leader and the head of the administrative system, all of whom, as a combined force, are out for lower-caste blood" (ix). The injustice that has been done to the Earth and its inhabitants is the main theme of these stories.

The short story titled "Seed" occupies the second position within the anthology. The primary subject of *Bitter Soil* centers around the examination of environmental injustice perpetrated against the Kuruda tribal community by those belonging to the upper caste zamindar class in a broader context. Injustice can be classified into two distinct types. Under the auspices of "Bhudanodyamam," there exists a process whereby unutilised lands are allocated to individuals lacking access to such resources, while concurrently, there exists a phenomenon wherein individuals engaged in agricultural labor are subjected to exploitative conditions devoid of a consistent income.

Kuruda village's surroundings resemble a desert that is baking under the hot sun: "The land north of Kuruda and Hesadi villages is uneven, arid, sun-baked" (22). Since the ground is arid and only contains a few neem trees and cactus plants here and there, not even grass can be found growing there. Old tribesman Dulan Ganju keeps watch over a boat-shaped plot of unproductive land that the landlord, Lachman Singh, gave to him. Dulan's home is a thatched cottage on a platform supported by wooden pillars in the center of the field. It is surprising to erect this type of cabin in a desolate area
