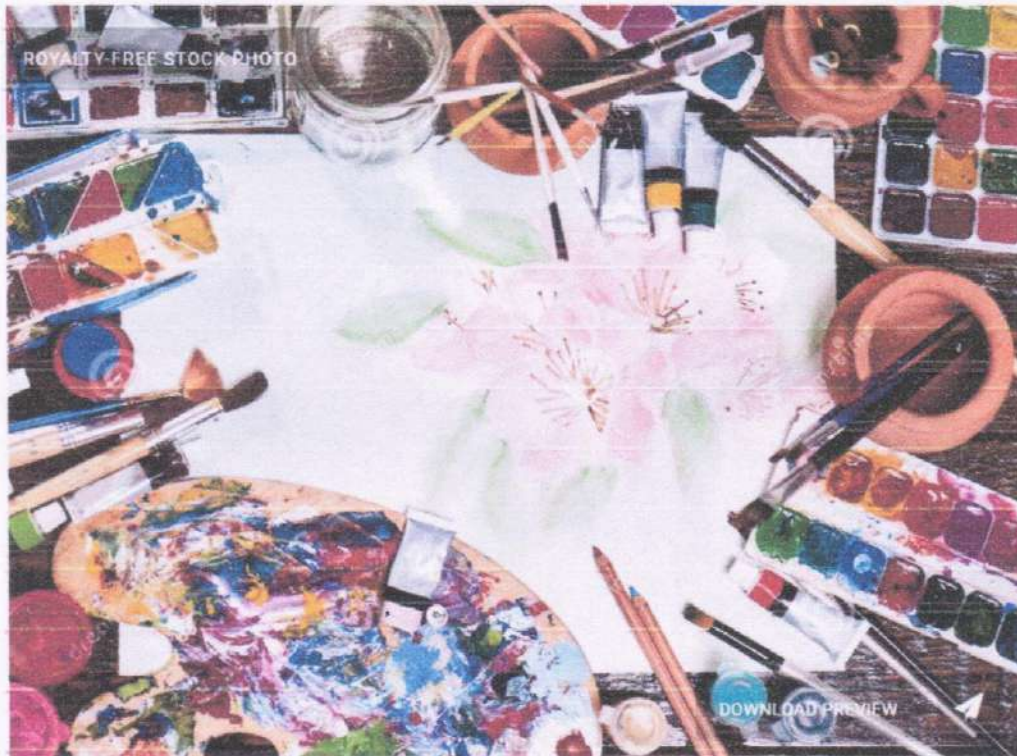

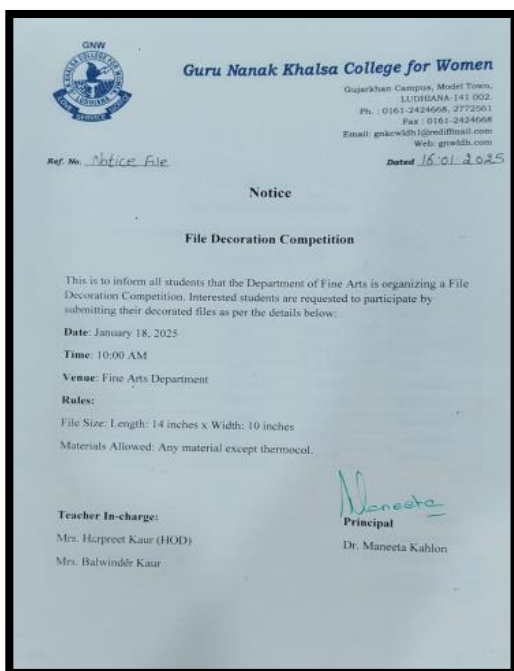
2. File Decoration Competition on January 18, 2025

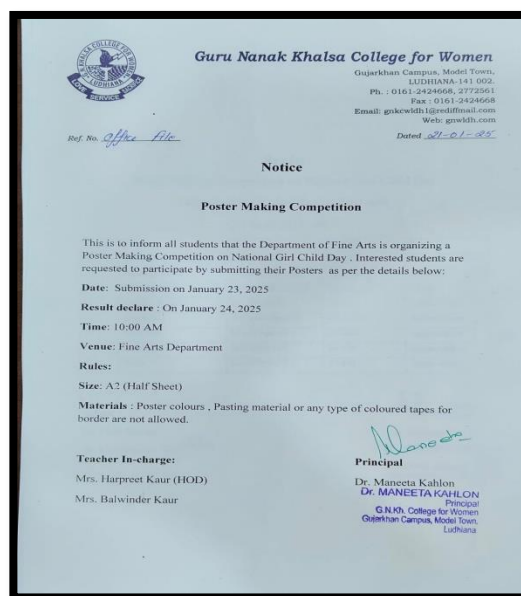
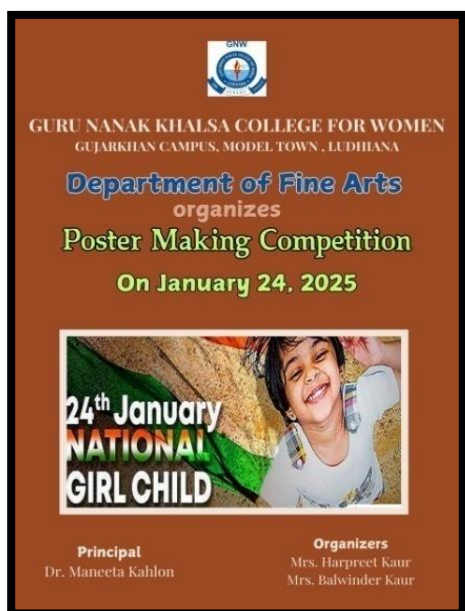

A 2D installation was created by students of the Fine Arts department, adding a creative touch to the campaign.

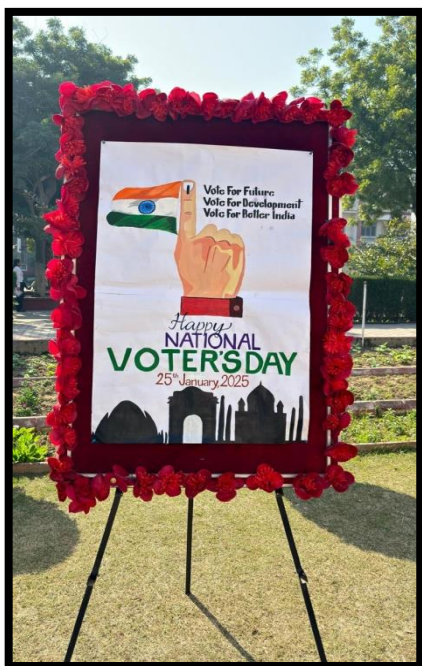

3rd Prize: ₹200/-

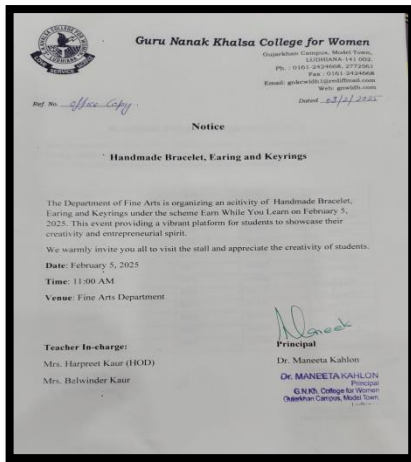
5 Appreciation Prizes: ₹150/- each

An Art Exhibition was also organized by the students under the guidance of Mrs. Harpreet Kaur, Head of the Department and Mrs. Balwinder Kaur.

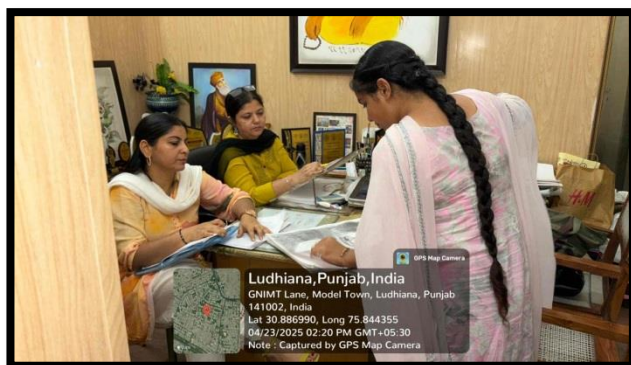
