Principal Dr. Maneeta Kahlon emphasized the importance of such industry interactions and highlighted the need to stay updated with emerging technologies.



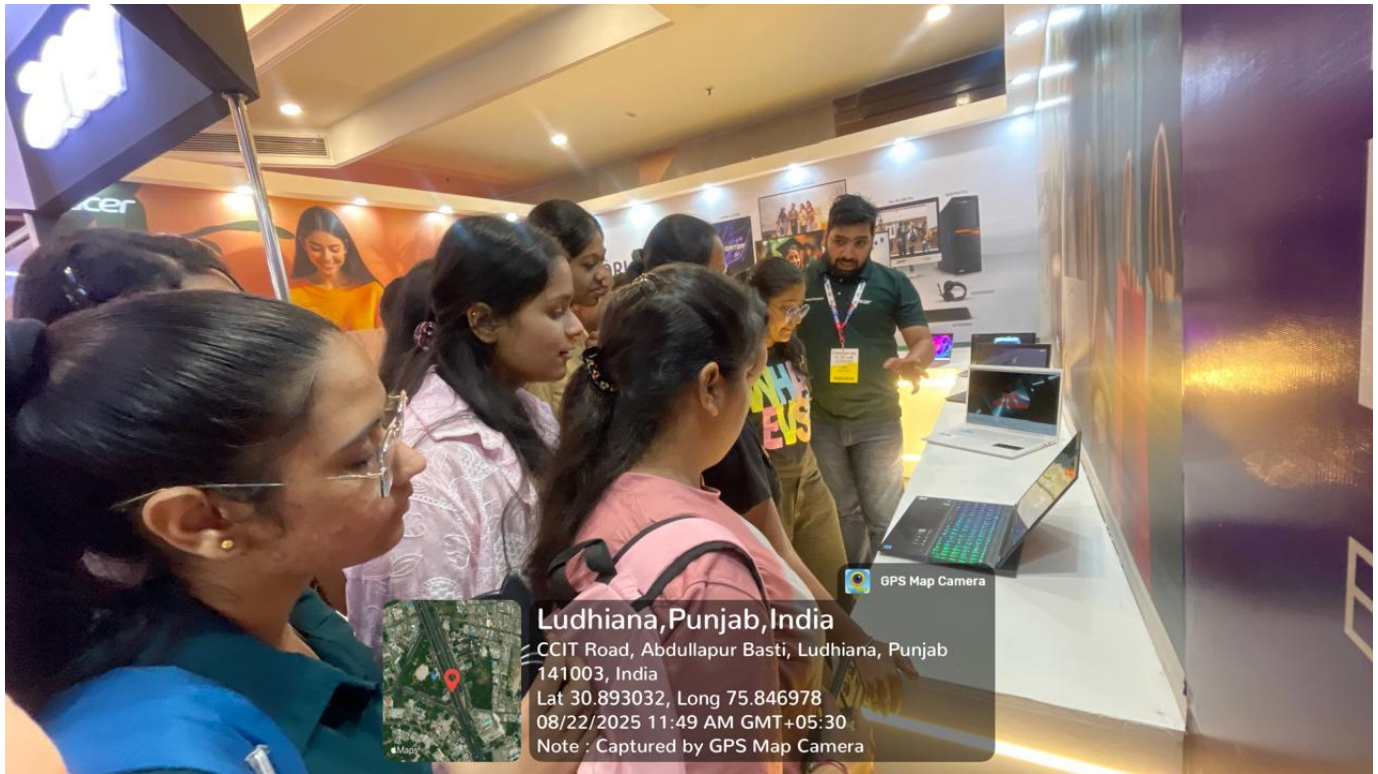

**Activity:** Teachers Day celebrations

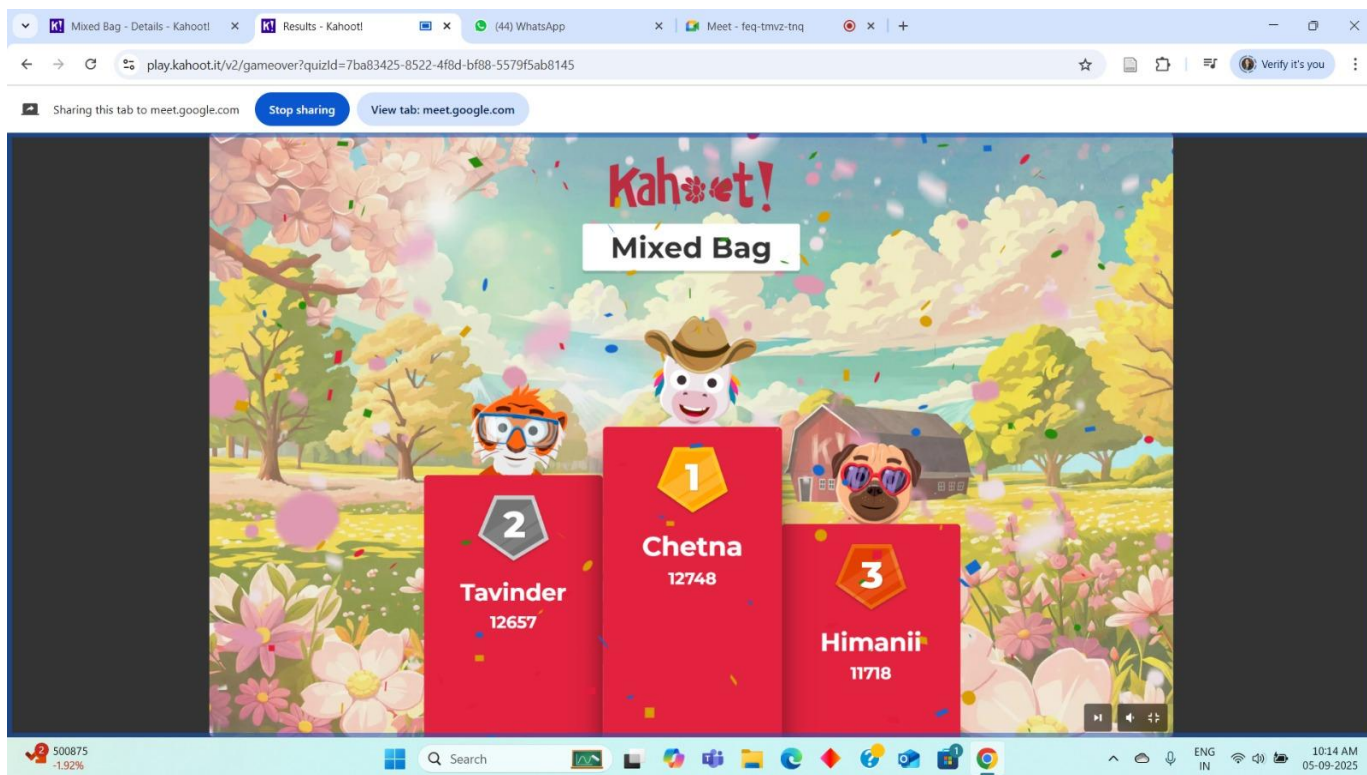
**Activity Details:** Teachers Day was celebrated in the online mode due to classes being held virtually because of the flood situation in the state. Online Quiz activity was organized for students.

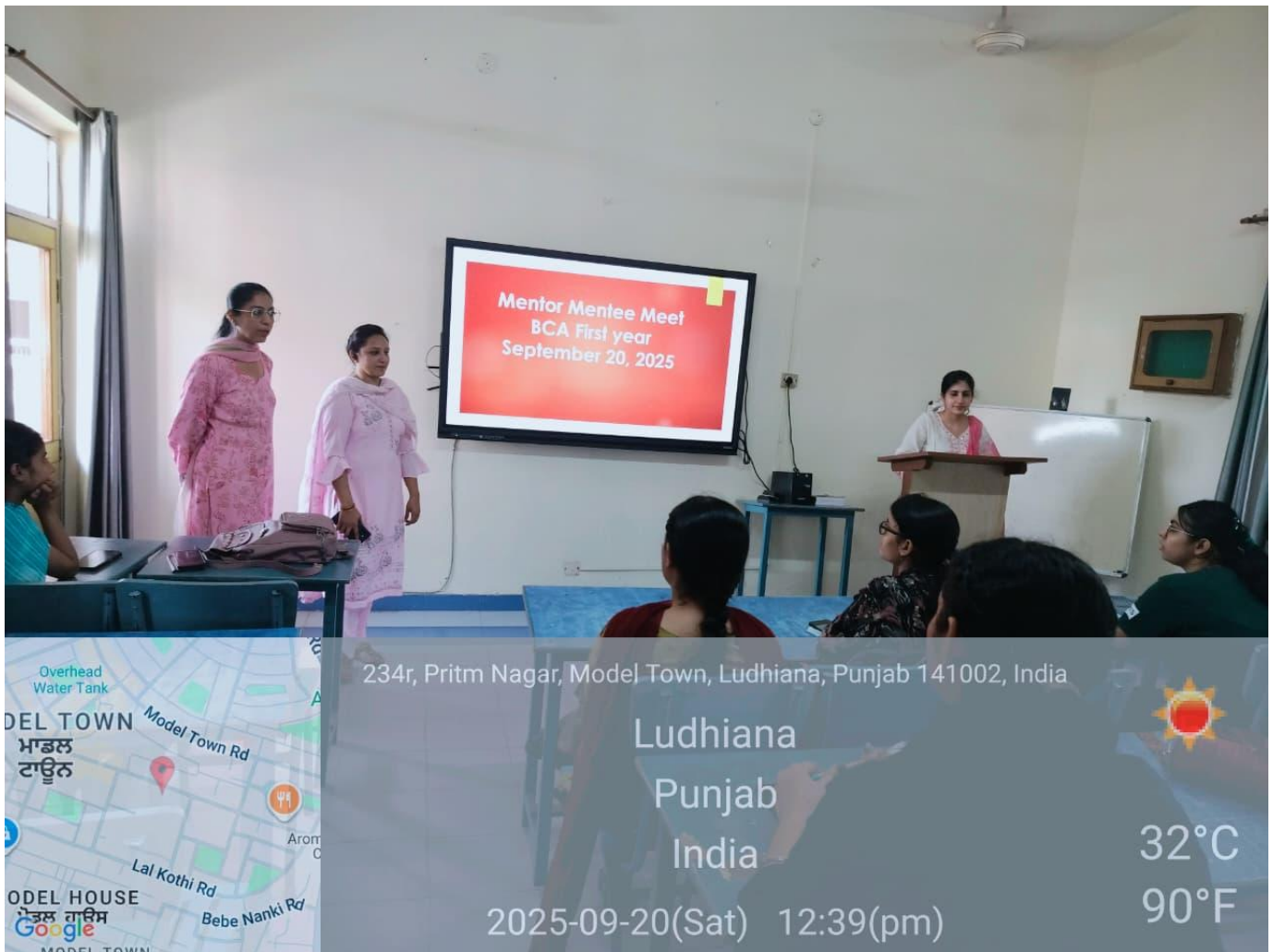




**Date:** September 20, 2025

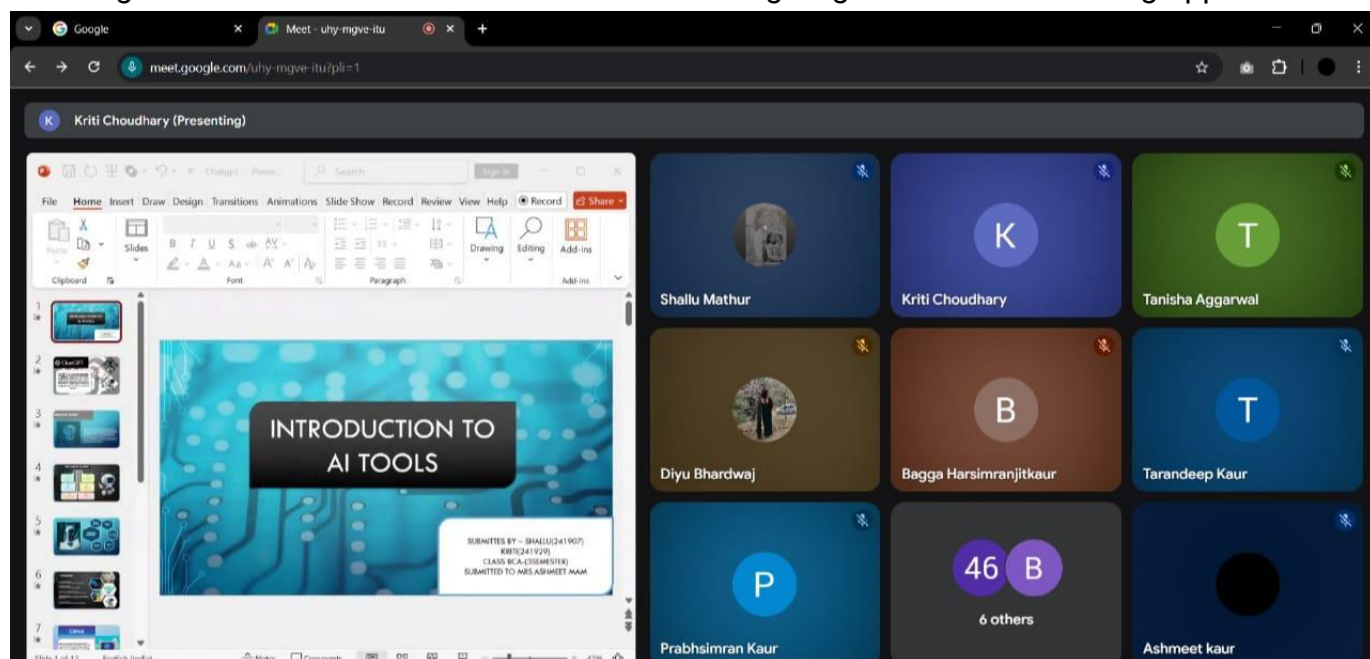
**Date:** October 2, 2025

**Activity:** Daan Ustav in collaboration with NSS Unit

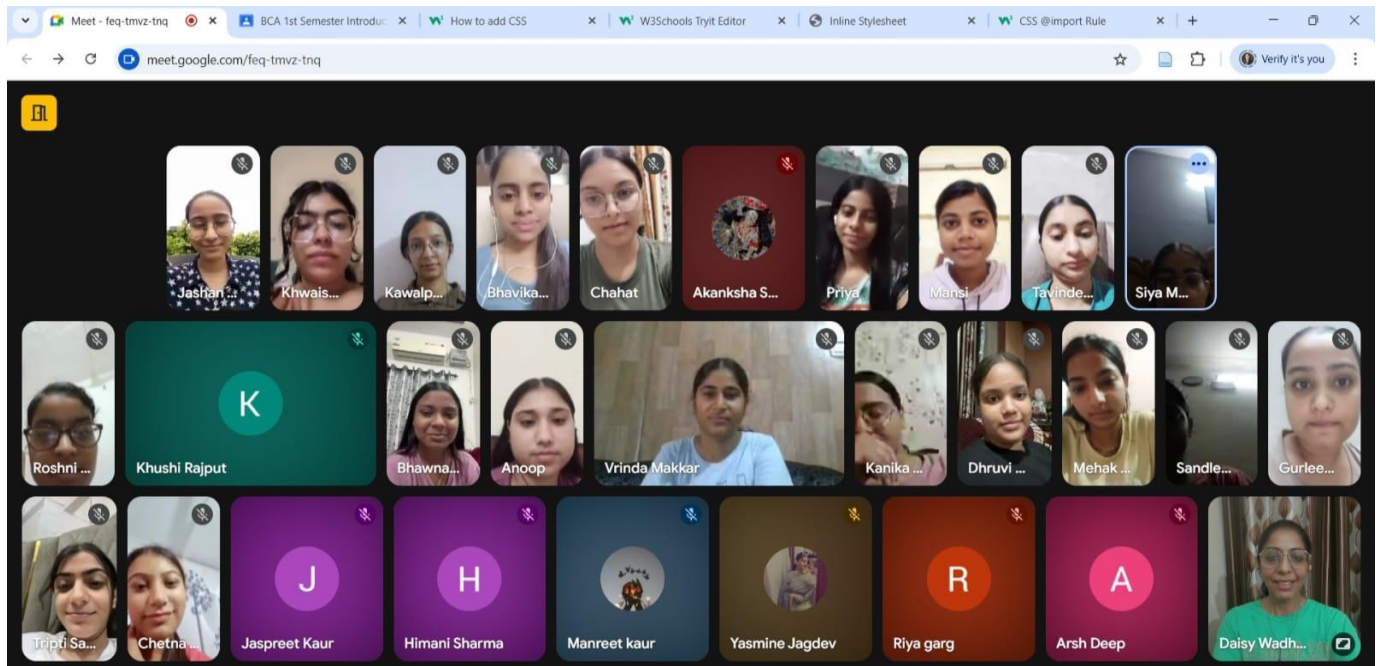

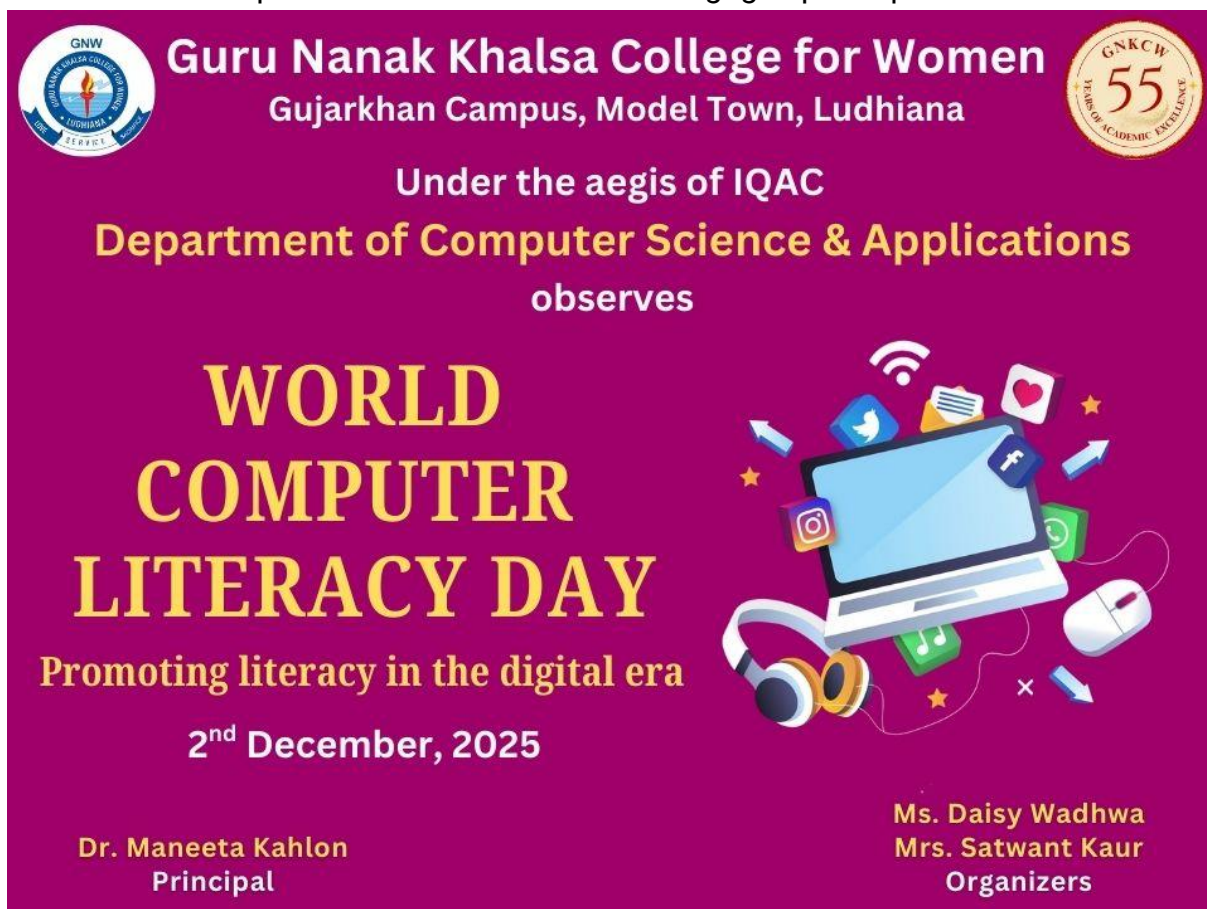
**Activity:** World Computer Literacy Day

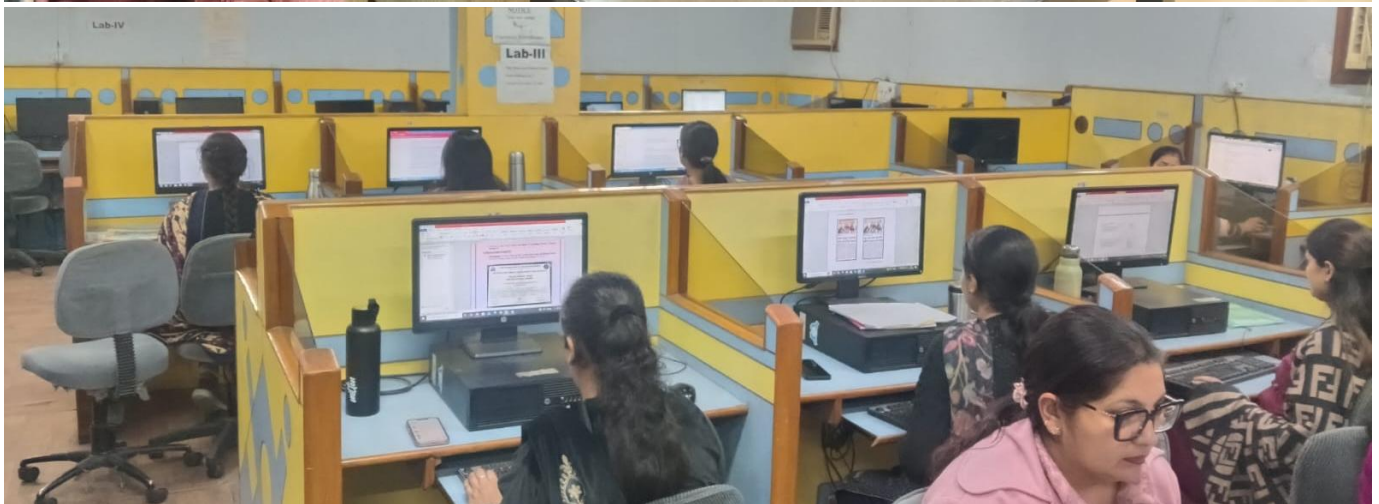

The workshop was conducted by the faculty members of the Computer Science Department, who demonstrated the practical use of AI Tools and engaged participants in hands-on activities.









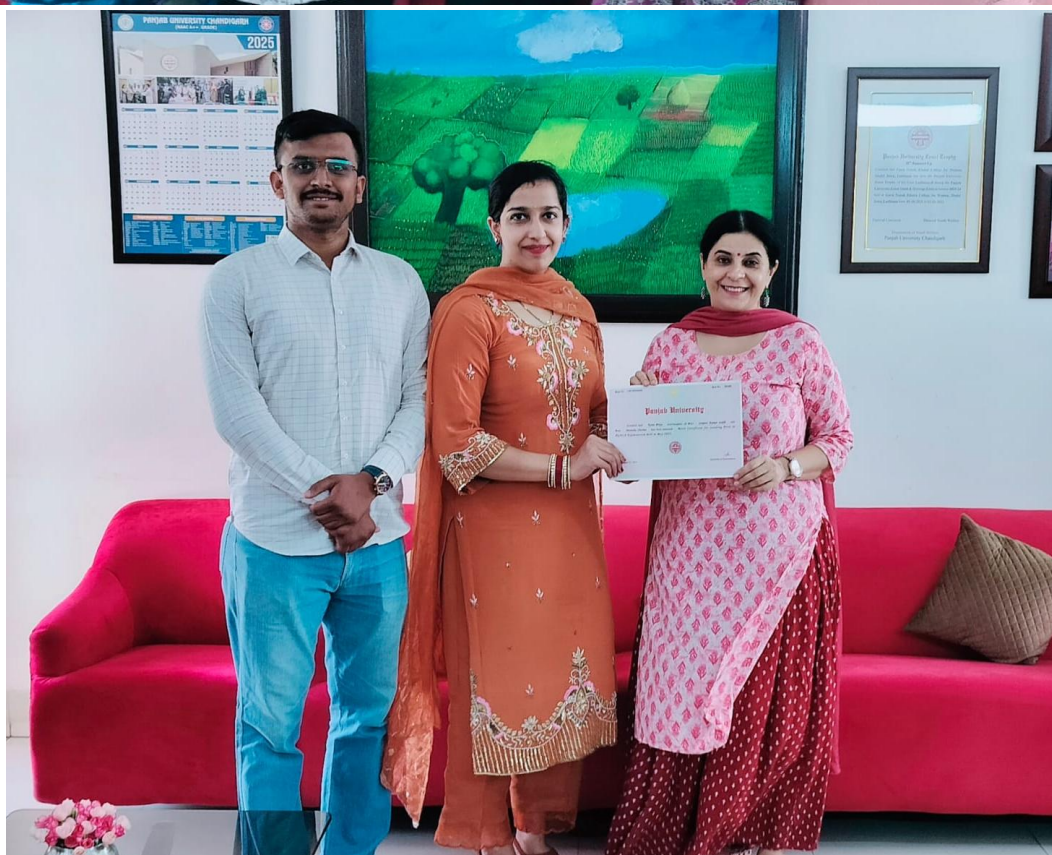


#### 4. Student participation in various activities
