D, the marks obtained in the NET will have 70% weightage and 30% weightage will be based on the performance in the interview/viva voce conducted by the University/HEI concerned. The Ph.D. admission will be based on the combined merit of NET marks and the marks obtained in the interview/viva voce.

D. The eligibility of the candidate is to be ensured by the institution. The category in which the candidate had appeared has been mentioned in the Score Card.

E. This certificate is only valid with the Score Card of JUNE 2025 UGC-NET which has been uploaded on the website of the NTA, i.e., <http://ugcnet.nta.ac.in>.

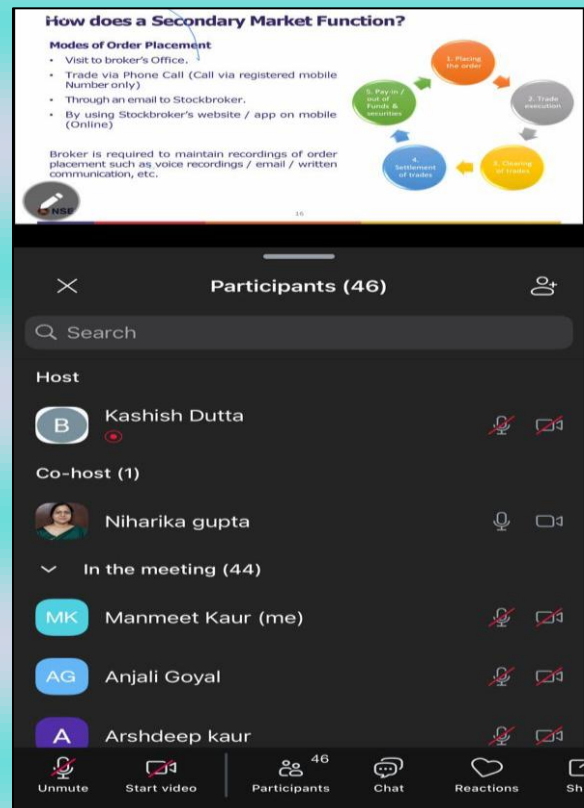
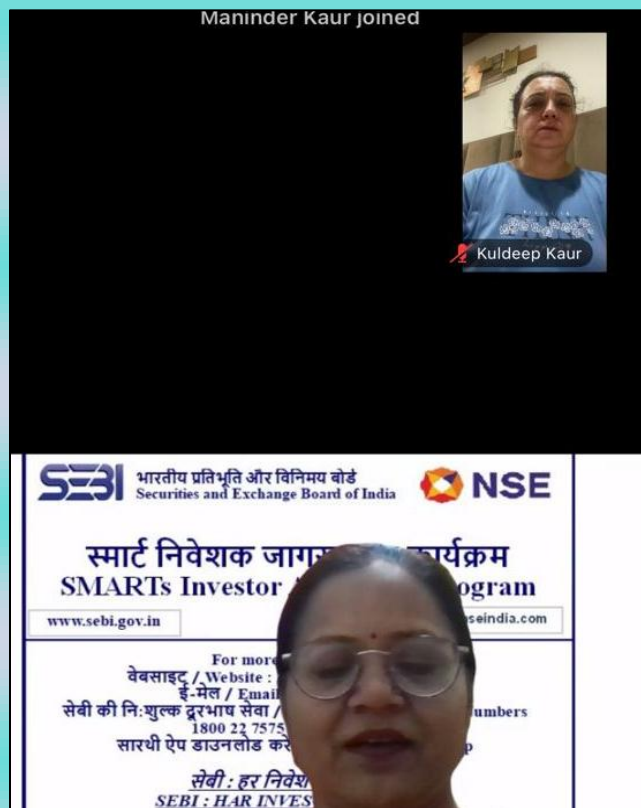
Activity	Ice-breaking session

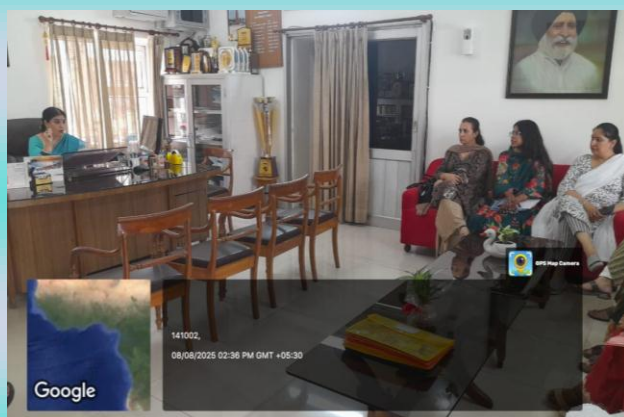
Activity	PowerPoint Presentations

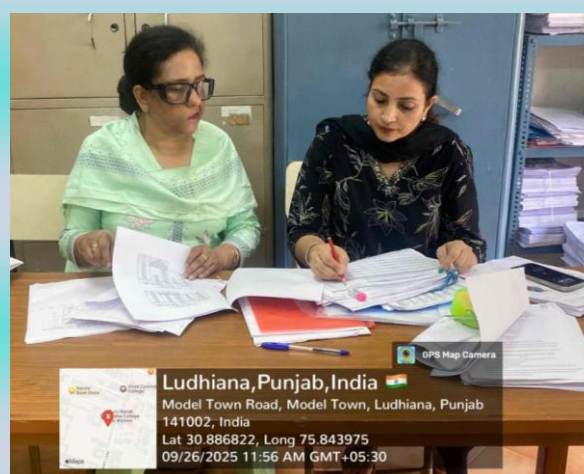
Activity	Student Mentoring Meet
