

Activity : Observe World Population Day


Activity Details : World World Population Day was observed on July 11, 2025 with the objective of spreading awareness about the rising population and its socio-economic implications.



Activity: Lecture on Intellectual Property Rights




Activity: Observed International Solidarity Day


The programme aimed to create awareness among faculty and students about consumer rights and responsibilities in the contemporary market scenario. 54 participants attended this event.
