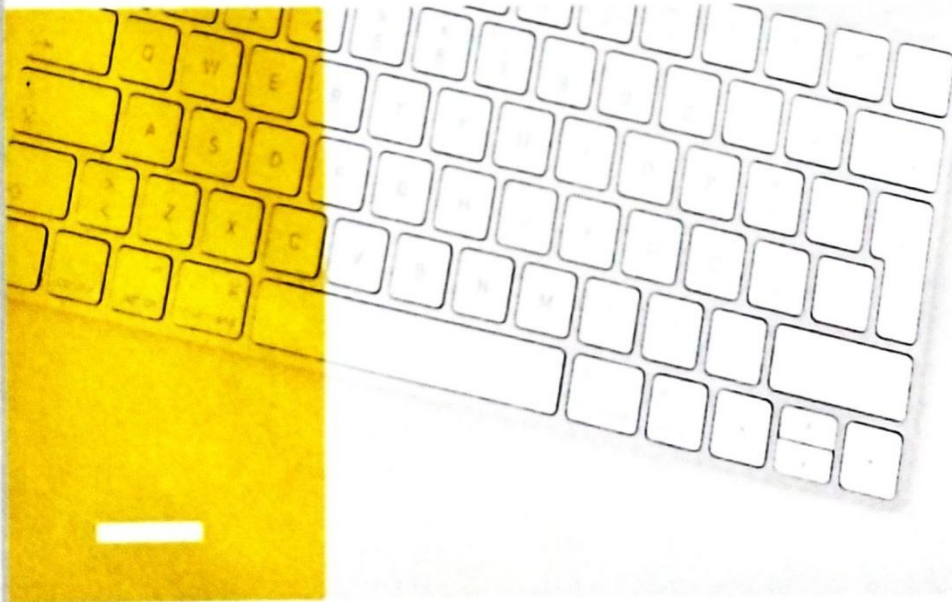

Activity: Department-level syllabus review meeting

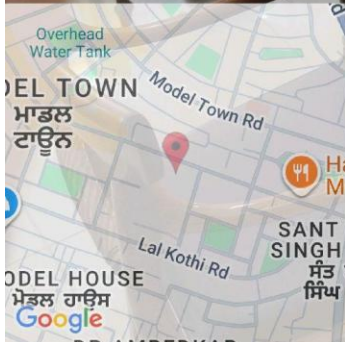

Activity: Educational visit to the Munjal Birmingham City University Centre of Innovation and Entrepreneurship (MBCIE), Ludhiana

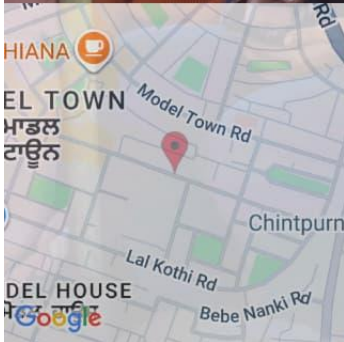

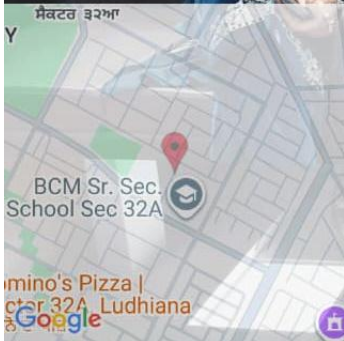
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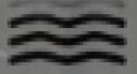
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Date: February 7, 2026
