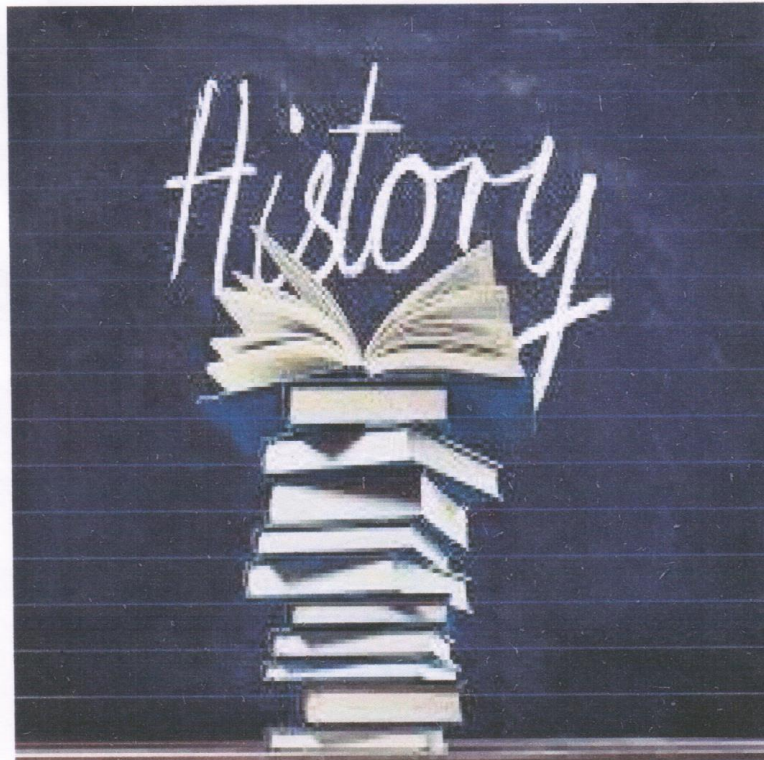




## 161st Birth Anniversary of Lala Lajpat Rai Ji

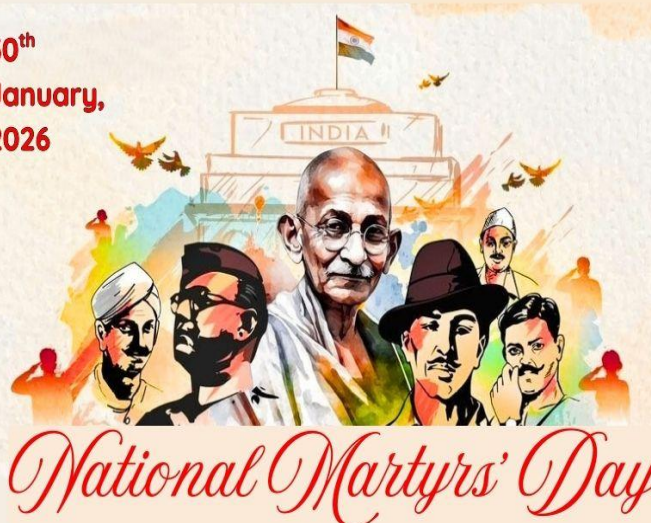


## Organized a Poster Making Competition

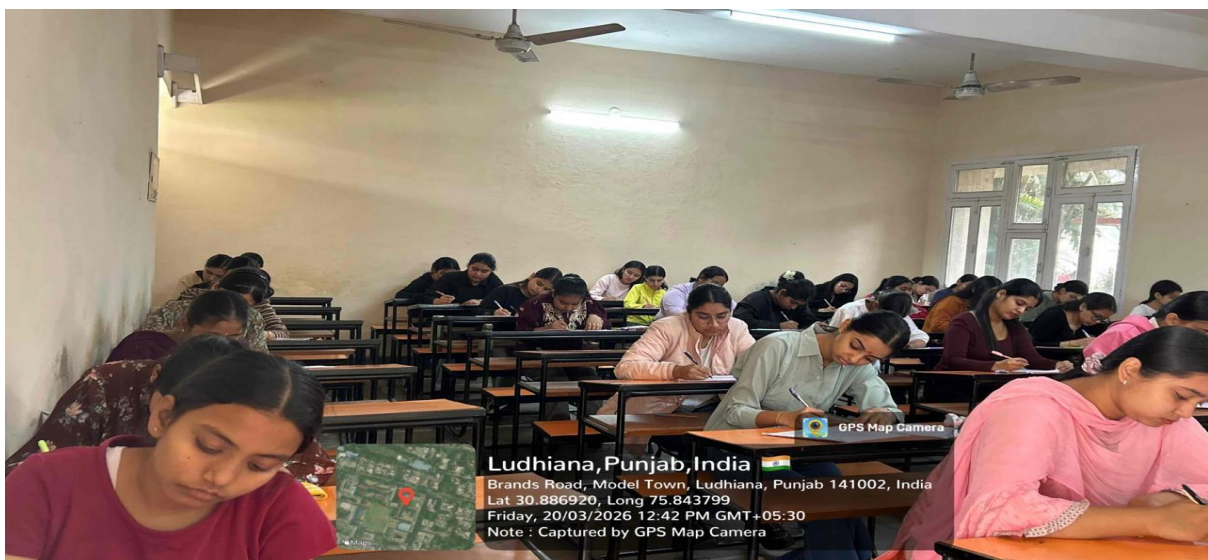

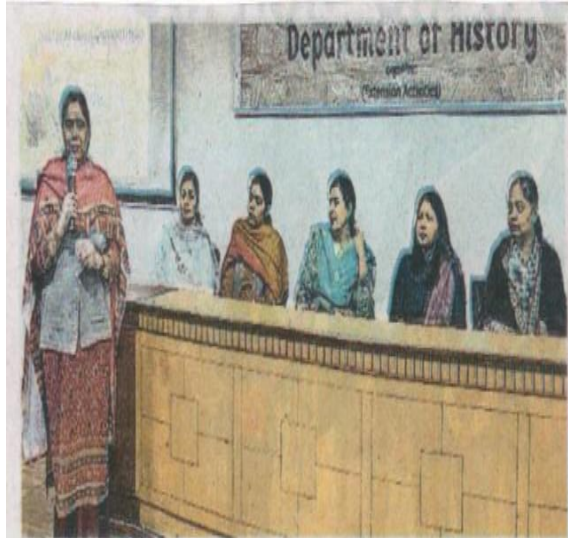


# विद्यार्थियों ने पोस्टर के माध्यम से किया देशभक्ति का प्रदर्शन
