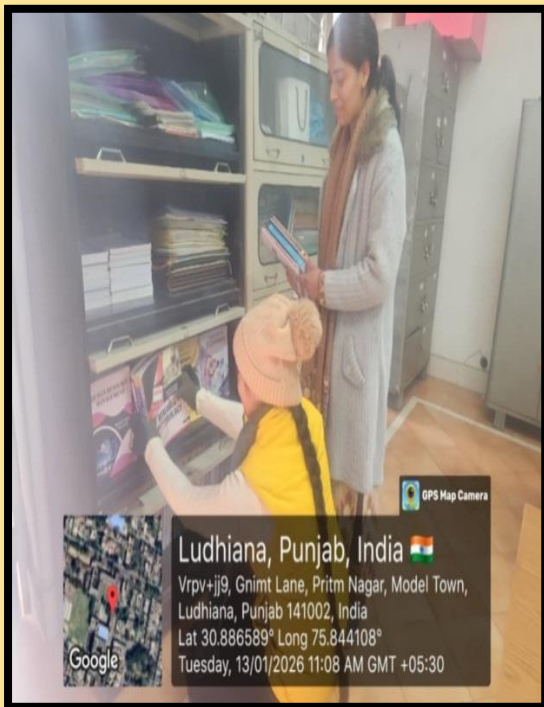

ACTIVITY: DISTRIBUTION OF BOOKS

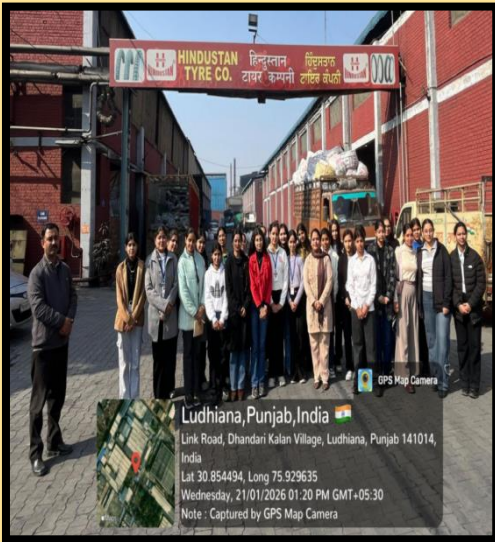

ACTIVITY: INDUSTRIAL VISIT

The Department organized an Industrial Visit to Hindustan Tyre Co. on January 21st, 2026 aiming to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical industrial exposure. During the visit, students explored the tyre and tube manufacturing unit, which is engaged in the production of a wide range of automobile tyres and tubes catering to two-wheelers, three-wheelers, and commercial vehicles. The program commenced with an informative address by the Head of HR, who warmly welcomed the students and briefed them about the company's vision, quality standards, safety measures, and work culture. This was followed by a detailed plant tour guided by the technical and HR personnel of the organization. Students were given a comprehensive understanding of the entire tyre and tube manufacturing process, starting from raw material procurement (natural and synthetic rubber, carbon black, chemicals), mixing and compounding, calendaring, bead making, tyre building, curing/vulcanization, inspection, testing, and final packaging. The students also learned about quality control mechanisms, machinery usage, and adherence to industrial safety norms followed at Hindustan Tyre Co. Later, the group visited the historic Gurudwara Sri Reru Sahib, where they learned about its spiritual significance and rich heritage. The visit offered students a moment of reflection and cultural connection, adding a meaningful dimension to the day's activities. After an insightful day, they were treated to a refreshing break at McDonald's to relax and enjoy a meal. The visit was successfully coordinated by Dr. Nidhi Sharma (Head of the Department) along with faculty members Dr. Minika Bawa, Ms. Manmeet Kaur Madhok, and Ms. Simranpreet Kaur.

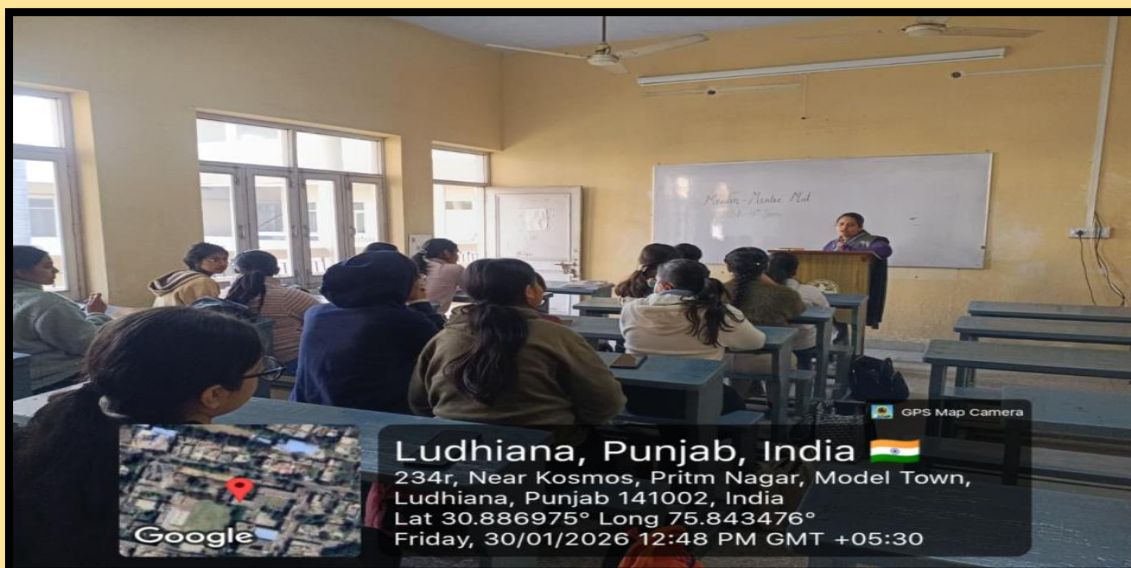

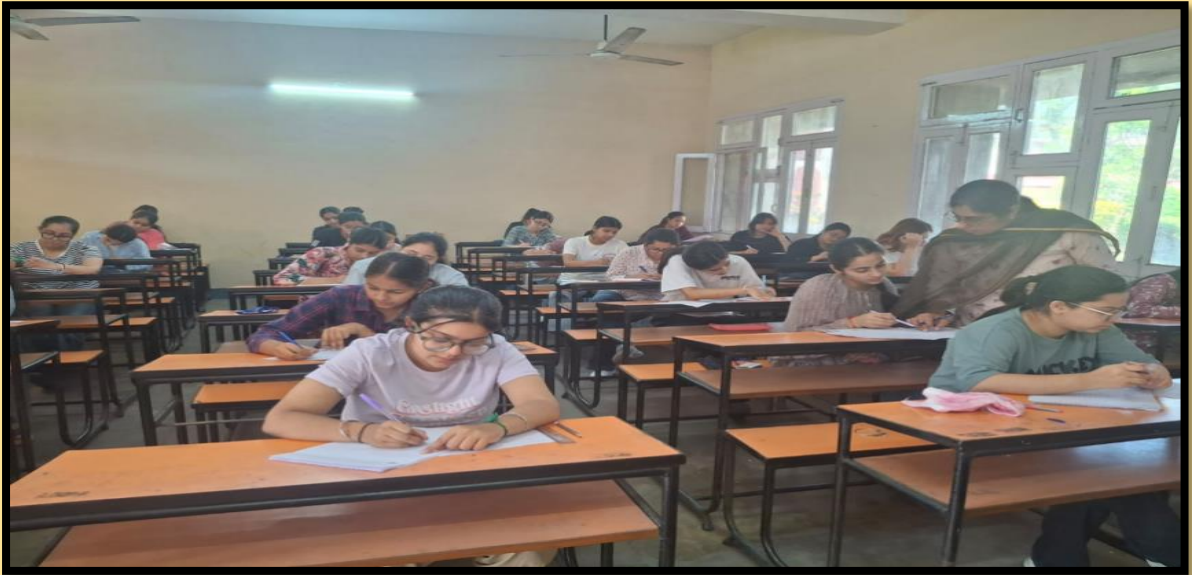

Mid Semester Exams were conducted in the college from March 19th to April 4th, 2026 in order to prepare students for the Panjab University Final Examination slated for April, 2026.


