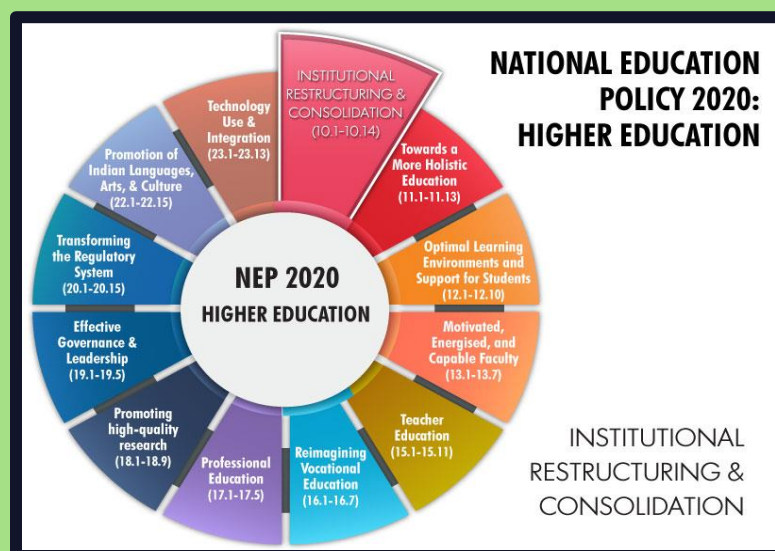

The Principal, Dr. Maneeta Kahlon, congratulated Pooja on her achievement and wished her continued success in her future endeavors.

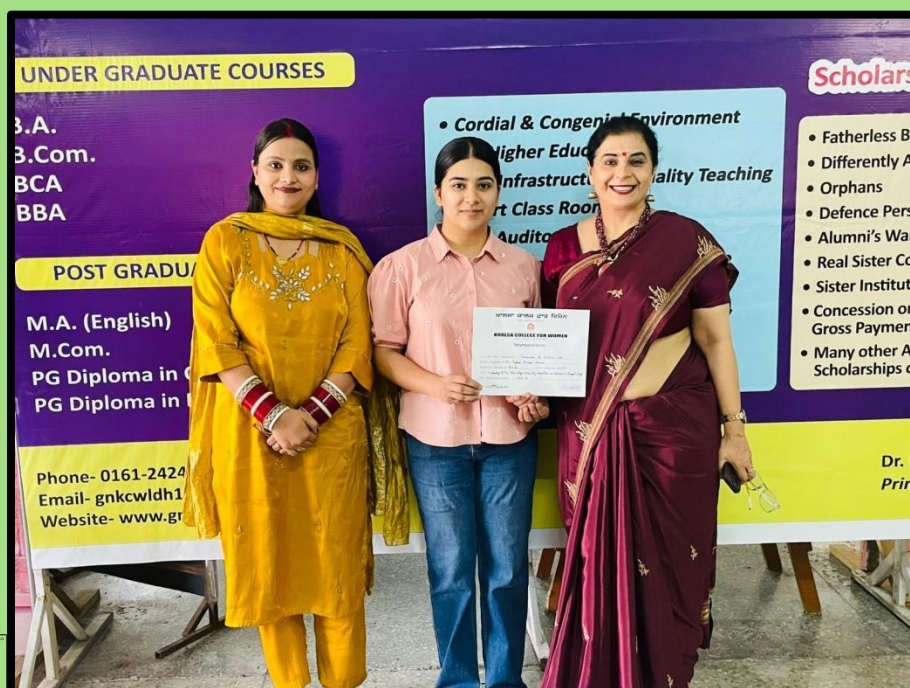




An online inter-college quiz competition
