the resource person for conducting such a creative and skill-oriented activity. She also encouraged the students to continue participating in such workshops to enhance their creativity and practical knowledge.





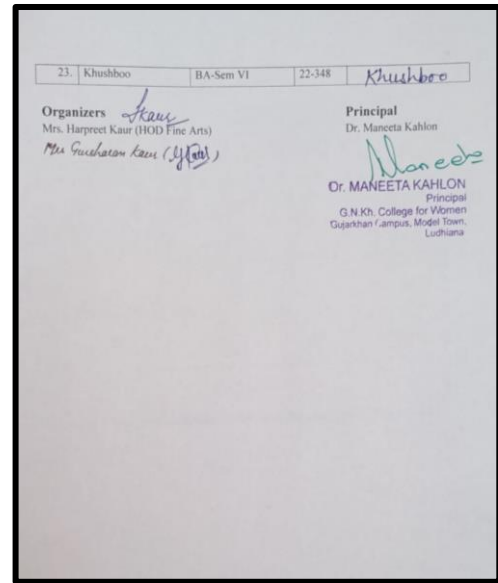
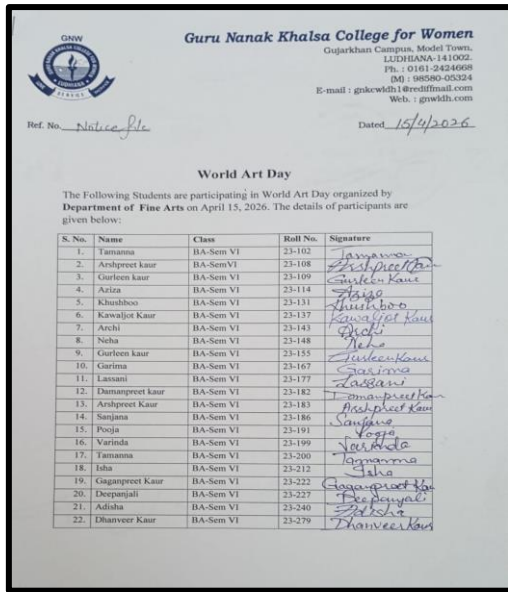
