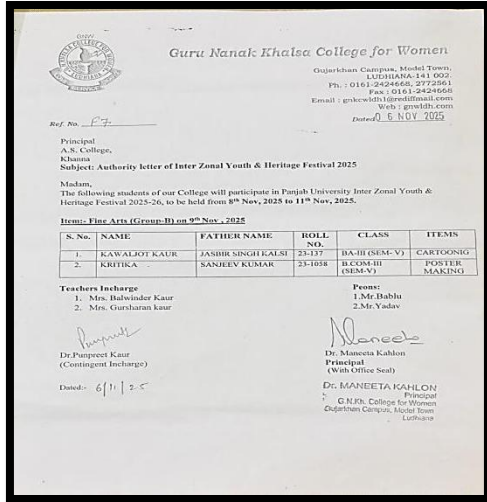




## 12. Panjab University Inter-Zonal Youth Festival November 9, 2025

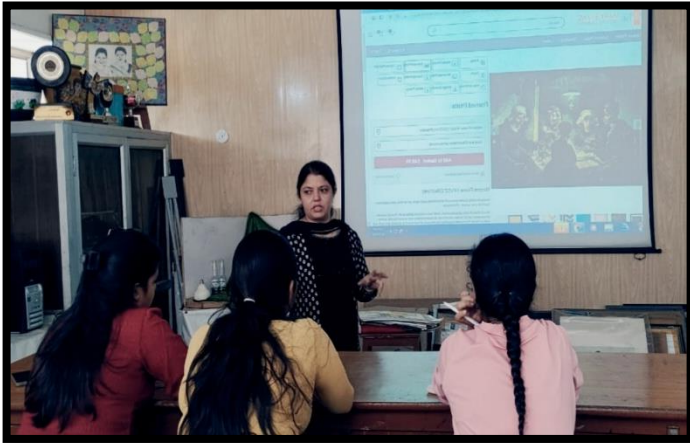

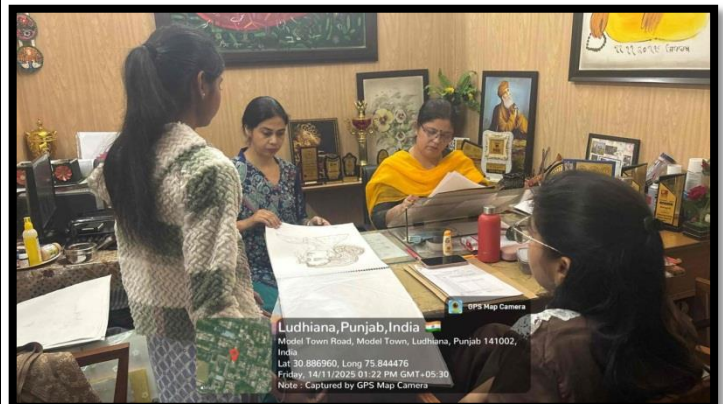
