**EXTENSION LECTURES**

- Under the aegis of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), the Department of Psychology, Guru Nanak Khalsa College for Women, Gujarkhan Campus, organized an Extension Lecture on “Mental Fitness and Resilience” for students on January 19, 2025. The session was conducted by Ms. Ankur, Organisational Psychologist, and Ms. Nandita, Community Psychologist, from MindPlus Clinic. The speakers highlighted the neuroscience of mental health and emphasized the importance of mental fitness. Practical strategies such as mindfulness, emotional regulation, stress management, and adaptive coping were discussed to help students enhance resilience and overall well-being. The programme was attended by Principal Dr. Maneeta Kahlon, faculty members, Mr. Rajeev Thapar from MindPlus Clinic, and students.

## WORKSHOPS

- A 7 day NSS camp was organised by the NSS Unit of Guru Nanak Khalsa College for Women on January 13, 2026. On the second day of the camp an insightful and spiritually enriching session was organised in the morning. The session was conducted by members of the Brahma Kumaris, who shared valuable thoughts on mental stress and its effects on daily life. They explained simple and effective ways to release stress, including laughter therapy and positive thinking techniques. The speakers encouraged students to stay positive, remove negativity from their minds, and lead a peaceful life. A practical meditation exercise was also conducted during the session, which helped students experience inner calm and relaxation.

On the third day of the camp, a health awareness session was conducted for NSS volunteers. Dr. Supriya, a physiotherapist from Krishna Charitable Hospital, Ludhiana, was the resource person. She highlighted the importance of physical fitness and correct body posture in daily life and demonstrated simple stretching and flexibility exercises to prevent muscle stiffness and fatigue. She also explained the correct postures to be followed while sitting, studying, and walking. The session also focused on stress management and mental well-being, helping students understand the link between physical and mental health..

The sessions focused on recognising symptoms, understanding risk factors, and learning practical First Aid action plans, enabling students to offer non-judgmental support and encourage professional help-seeking.
